

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on May 13, 2003, at 6:30 p.m. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, Council members: Clarence Alexander, Bert Collins, Kent Chambers, Brian Brown and Clerk Judy Fortenberry. Council member Mosteller was absence due to family obligations.

Guest: Deputy Campbell

After roll call Mayor Livingston call the meeting to order and asked Mr. Collins to open the meeting with prayer.

Mayor Livingston asked if everyone had read minutes of the May 8, 2003, regular council meeting. Mr. Collins motion to approve, Mr. Alexander seconded, carried.

A. FINANCE & EDUCATION - MR. MOSTELLER

Mayor Livingston set date for budget work session on May 28 or 29, Clerk to check with Mr. Mosteller to set up the date.

B. UTILITIES – MR. ALEXANDER

Mr. Alexander reported he had talked with Mr. Davis with Joe Wheeler EMC concerning the 4-way, reported that Mr. Davis said the wires were to low, but he would like to get with Mr. Stisher and the Council before doing anything to correct the problem. Clerk will call Mr. Stisher and Mr. Davis and set up a date to go over the needs for the 4-way.

He also reported the 6" water line installed on Ryan Road, we will need to check and see if the Town needs to install a new fire hydrant. Mayor will check with Fire Department on the need.

C. STREETS, PARKS, & CEMETERIES – Mr. BROWN

Mr. Brown reported on the April 22 meeting with Mr. Stisher, no state money to replace the culvert at the school. The County will need funding from the Town on this project in the amount of approximately \$25,000 also; once the new playground is completed the Town will need to redo the drainage on Gravel Ridge Road. Will discuss at the budget work session.

Park backstop has not been repaired, was to be done before the start of the season, Clerk will call fence company and pay out of Activities fund.

Still have an odor at the ballpark, Clerk will call and have septic tank pumped at the MPC.

Clerk reported overhead doors at storage and concession stand had been repaired.

D. POLICE & FIRE – MR CHAMBERS

Mr. Chambers reported 6 EMT, and 1 grass fire for the month of April.

Deputy reported he had one complaint on kids doing do-nuts in the parking lot at the park.

E. RECREATION & SANITATION – MR. COLLINS

Mr. Collins reported on meeting with EPA in Destin, FL on May 21-22, Clerk to attend.

Mr. Collins reported that Mr. Kitchens has an icemaker for sale for \$1,200, used one year, and was new when purchased. Mr. Collins and Mr. Alexander will go look at the icemaker, if they feel it is worth \$1,200 then they can purchase for the MPC, with the understanding that it works.

The Mayor will get with Don Stisher and see about spraying the town for Mosquitoes.
