

Minutes of the regular meeting of the Eva Town Council held on November 13, 2000, at 6:30 p.m. in the Eva Town Hall. Present: Mayor Gary Livingston, Brian Brown, Clarence Alexander, Bert Collins, Larry Smith and Judy Fortenberry. C. C. Mosteller was absence due to family commitment.

After roll call Mr. Collins opened with prayer. Mr. Brown made motion to approve minutes from October Regular Meeting, Mr. Collins second, carried.

Mayor thanked Council Members for changing meeting night. Reminded everyone present of the lunch meeting at the Eva School on November 14, at 11:45.

Mayor also, reported that the Library would hold a ribbon cutting and open house on November 19, from 2-4:00 p.m., for the new wing. Mayor stated that all landscaping and remaining work would be completed by this date.

#### **FINANCE & EDUCATION - MR. MOSTELLER**

Mayor reported that the money received from the sell of the Old Town Hall had been placed in a CD earmarked for the New Town Hall, at the interest rate of a yield of 7.2%.

#### **UTILITIES - MR. ALEXANDER**

Mr. Alexander reported that the water line from Cullman was being replaced by larger pipe. And that Water Department had stated that the lake was up 2 feet.

Mr. Alexander reported that he had been approached by a community member about doing an ordinance against putting up communication towers in the Town's limits. Mayor suggested that we table this discussion for a later date.

#### **STREETS, PARKS, & CEMETERIES - MR. BROWN**

Mr. Brown reported that he had changed all locks at the ballpark, due to the vandalism to the tractor.

Also, reported that Don Shaver is building handicap ramp at rest rooms.

Suggested that we turn the horseshoe pit into a pavilion. This was discussed in detail and agreed that the building would probably be utilized more as a pavilion, but if this should take place that we would need to keep a couple of the lanes.

Mr. Brown stated that he had talked with State personnel about a water flow study at the ballpark.

Mayor and Mr. Brown will meet with Donald Ray Morgan and check if we could use some of his land when doing construction on the culvert at the school.

Mr. Alexander reported that he had got Joe Hill to do some work at the cemetery, upper side and had reworked the old drain. Paid \$180. out of the Methodist Church Cemetery Fund.

Paving the cemetery road was brought up; Mr. Brown ask if we have to use Shelby to pave the road. Mayor reported that we use Shelby because we get the county contract price. Mayor stated he would check with Mr. Stisher about this road.

### **POLICE & FIRE - MR. SMITH**

Mr. Smith reported fire department had been busy with EMT and fire calls this past month. Reported that the new brush truck is working great.

Still looking at disposing of trucks being replaced.

Mayor reported that the fire department has three new members, two Timmy and Hollie Newman are EMT's. Ray Cheatman is now working so he can come back to making calls, Rickey Wallace is going to EMT School and Brian Brown has signed up.

Mayor suggested that Clerk write letter to Ebenezer and thank them for all the assistance they have given to us during the past.

No police report.
