



Always use swisscovery **UNIGE!**

Prerequisite to borrow/request: the registration



With my swisscovery account, I can...

 Borrow up to 100 documents (usually for 28 days, with 5 automatic renewals of 28 days each)



 Order, free of charge, documents from other libraries in the SLSP network or outside the network



 Request, free of charge, digitizations of certain documents




Pay attention to fees!!!


All notifications are sent **by email**: check your email regularly (including spam) and your swisscovery account.

```
1 day after loan term: free reminder
+ 6 days: 1<sup>st</sup> reminder: 5 CHF per document
+ 6 days: 2<sup>nd</sup> reminder: + 5 CHF
+ 6 days: 3<sup>rd</sup> reminder: + 10 CHF
```






Tips for locating a physical document in swisscovery (1/2)




- 1) Enter only relevant keywords in the search bar, without punctuation
- 2) Start with the search scope "swisscovery UNIGE"
- (= documents from the UNIGE Library)

Tips for locating a physical document in swisscovery (2/2)

3) Use filters after launching the search, for instance

- 1. You must prepare a presentation on the **impact of screens on young children's academic success**. Identify in swisscovery **a relevant book** (available at UNIGE) and **an article**.
- 2. Compare the search strategies used and the references found with your neighbors.


If I can't find what I'm looking for ...

- 1. Control and adapt my keywords
- Choose a wider search scope (→ Geneva → swisscovery → swisscovery plus)
- 3. Fill in the form for « Interlibrary loan/digitization »

 Ask librarians for help: at the literature search services (Uni Mail and Uni Bastions -Jura) or at reception desks
