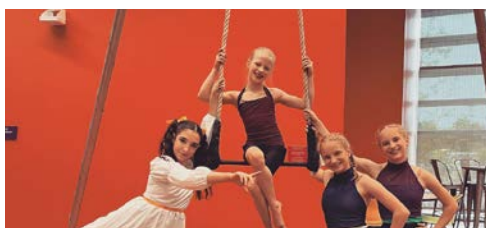
About
