- ▶ The Kentucky Safe Infants Act allows parents to leave their newborn infant (*younger than 30 days old*) with the staff member of a “Safe Haven.”
- ▶ Parents may leave them safely, securely, and anonymously if they are unable to care for their newborn, without fear of criminal prosecution or allegations of neglect.
- ▶ Safe Havens can include hospitals, staffed police departments, staffed fire stations, staffed emergency medical service stations, & staffed participating places of worship
