In continuation of this initiative, BIS Mumbai Branch Office proposes to conduct a "Manak Manthan" seminar on IS 14756 – Standard for Stainless Steel Utensils in collaboration with the Stainless Steel Merchants' Association (SSMA) on 10<sup>th</sup> November 2025. The session will focus on the latest amendments, practical implementation aspects, and stakeholder interaction related to the standard.

The programme aims to create awareness among industry members and manufacturers about the scope and application of the standard and to address any queries or suggestions from stakeholders.

As the Stainless Steel Merchants' Association (SSMA) is the apex association representing all manufacturers of stainless steel utensils as per IS 14756, it is imperative that such a technical deliberation be held as a joint collaborative approach to standardization between BIS and SSMA. A detailed programme schedule will be prepared in consultation with SSMA accordingly.
