Step 1

Connect the Rage R550 USB to your iPhone via the USB Type-C port.



Step 2

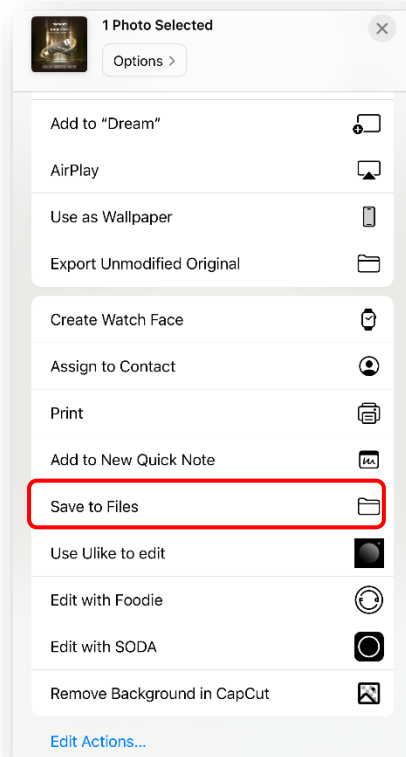
Select the photos, videos, or files you want to save to the Rage R550. Then, tap the **"Share"** icon located in the lower-left corner of your screen. (The icon highlighted in red square)





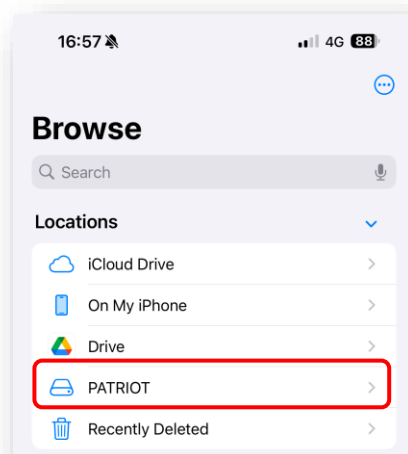
Step 3

Choose **"Save to Files"** from the sharing options. (The icon highlighted in red square)



Step 4

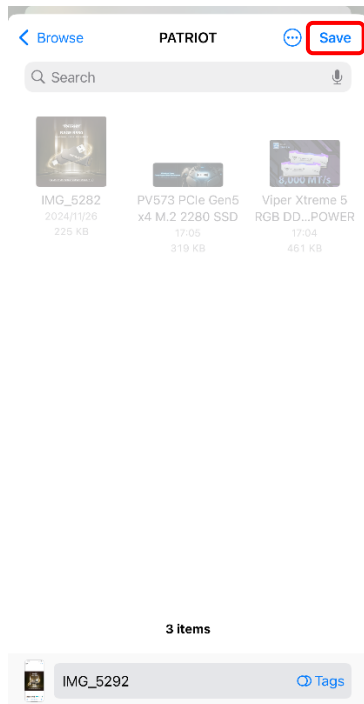
Select **"PATRIOT"** as the destination folder. (The icon highlighted in red square)





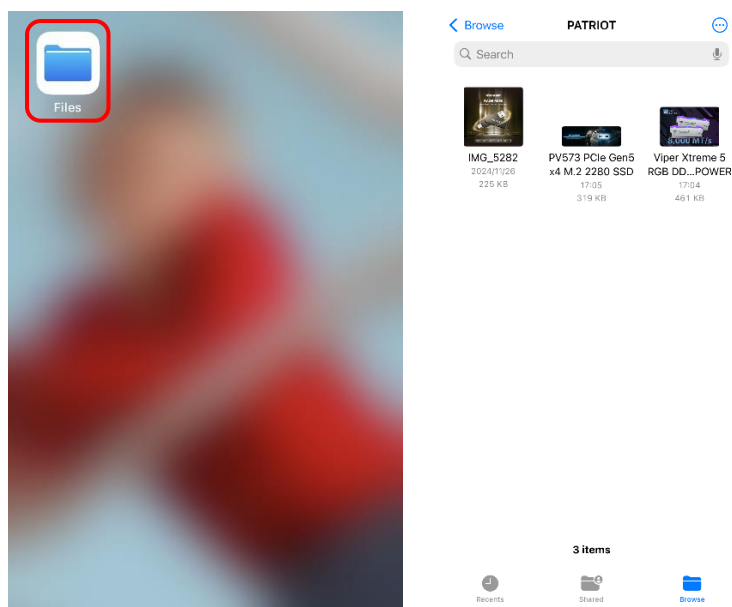
Step 5

To access your saved content, open the **"Files"** app and navigate to the **"PATRIOT"** folder.
