To align with industry best practices for security and data integrity and to maintain PCI compliance, as of **July 1, 2025**, we will be updating our minimum system requirements.

Minimum System Requirements, effective July 1, 2025:

- **Windows**: Windows 10+ and Microsoft Edge are required. The latest version of Windows products can be downloaded from the [Microsoft Download Center](#).
- **Mac**: Mac OS X 10.15.7+ and Safari 15 or later are required. The latest version of Mac products can be downloaded from the [Mac Support](#) site.
- **iPad**: iOS 16.0
