

COOKIE POLICY

This document provides information about storing and accessing information already stored in the telecommunications end-user's device.

The platform stores and accesses the aforementioned information using the following solutions:

1. cookies - small text files recorded and stored on the user's telecommunications terminal equipment to identify the user (e.g. to maintain a session) or to retain for future reference the configuration of an electronically supplied service;
2. Session Storage - objects saved and stored in the memory of the web browser using the Storage interface no longer than until either the Platform tab or the entire web browser is closed.

COOKIE FILES

The platform uses the following cookies (saves and accesses them):

Necessary cookies - necessary for the proper functioning of the Platform, used to provide the service provided electronically without obtaining the user's separate consent.

Optional cookies - unnecessary for the proper functioning of the Platform, including functional and analytical cookies, used with the user's separate consent.

The cookie settings (consent for optional cookies) can be changed using the functionality of the installed web browser. Below we indicate examples of the actions in the most popular web browsers:

Google Chrome: settings in the "Privacy and security" tab

Microsoft Edge: settings under the tab "Site Permissions"

Mozilla Firefox: settings in the "Privacy and security" tab

Opera: settings under the tab "Privacy and security"

Safari: settings under the "Privacy" tab

SESSION STORAGE

The Platform uses Session Storage objects only to the extent necessary for the proper functioning of the Platform, including for the authentication of the logged-in user (session maintenance).

It is not possible to change the settings for Session Storage objects.
