COOKIE POLICY

This document provides information about storing and accessing information already stored in the telecommunications end-user's device.

The platform stores and accesses the aforementioned information using the following solutions:

- 1. cookies small text files recorded and stored on the user's telecommunications terminal equipment to identify the user (e.g. to maintain a session) or to retain for future reference the configuration of an electronically supplied service;
- Session Storage objects saved and stored in the memory of the web browser using the Storage interface no longer than until either the Platform tab or the entire web browser is closed.
