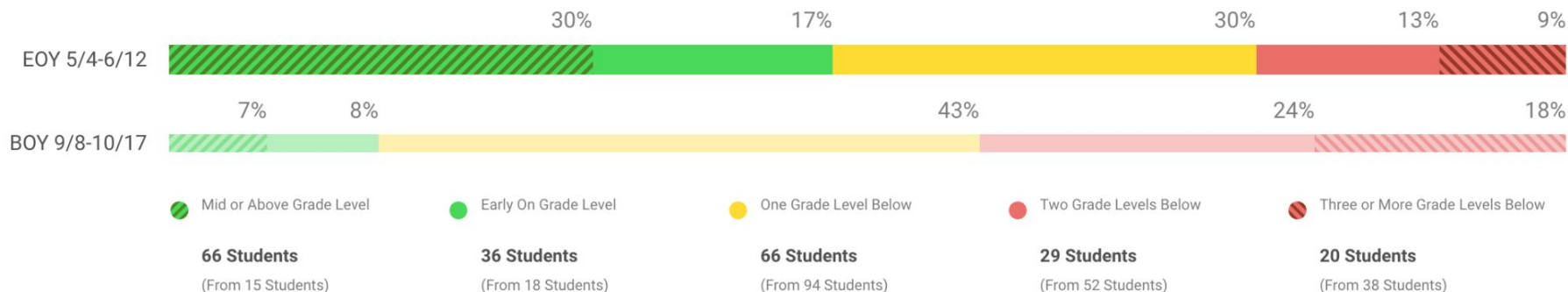

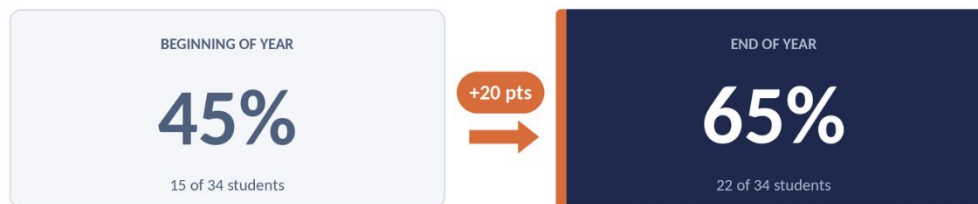

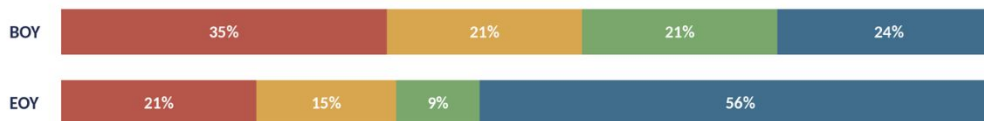
Percent of kindergartners meeting the Reading Composite benchmark

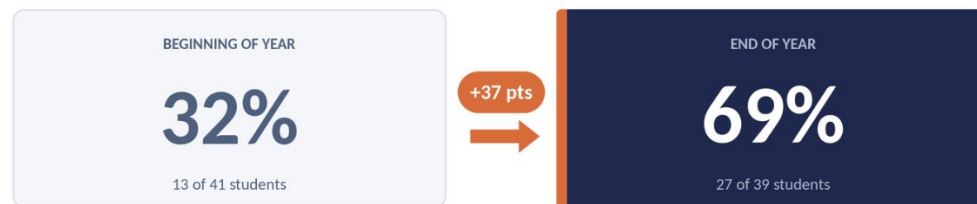
First Grade Reading Growth

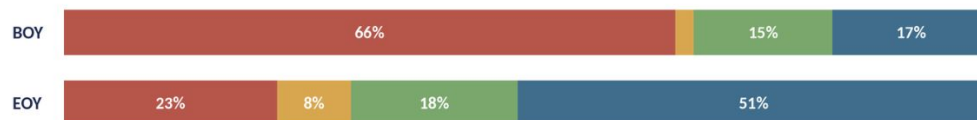
Percent of first graders meeting the Reading Composite benchmark

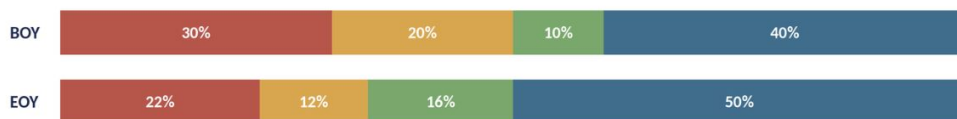
Percent of second graders meeting the Reading Composite benchmark

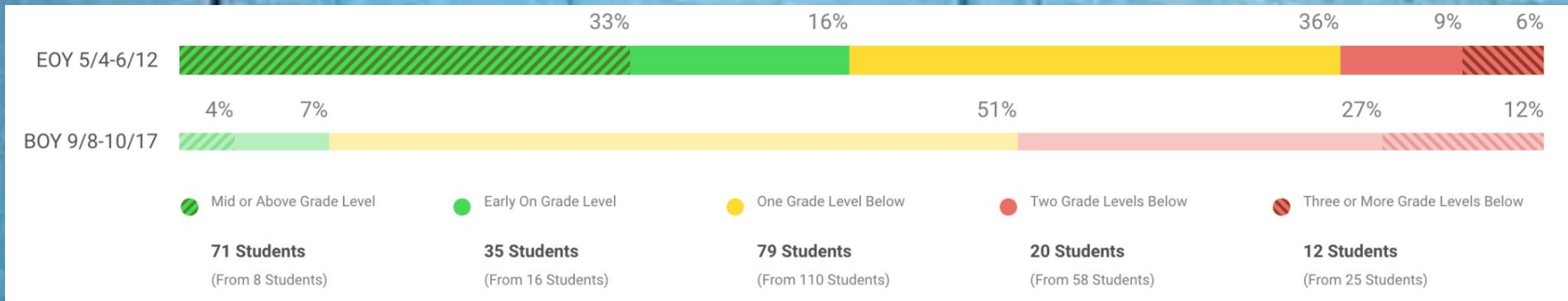
