# Colorado Paid Family and Medical Leave (CO PFML)



The Colorado Family and Medical Leave Insurance (FAMLI) program provides partial income replacement for approved family leaves, safe leaves, and medical leaves. If you are approved for CO PFML, you may be provided a weekly benefit if you are unable to work due to:

### Family, Medical and Safe Leave

- Your own serious health condition
- To bond with your new child (birth, adoption, or foster-care placement)
- Care for a covered family member with a serious health condition
- Make arrangements for a family member's military deployment
- Address issues related to sexual assault and/or domestic violence for you or a family member

To be eligible for benefits you must meet eligibility requirements of the law. See your employer for details.

# Colorado PFML features

After your claim is approved, you:

- Get a weekly benefit that replaces a portion of your income up to a maximum set by the state of Colorado. Learn how your benefit is calculated and about the maximum benefit payment by visiting famli.colorado.gov.
- Receive a weekly benefit for up to a certain number of weeks per 52week period:
  - A combined total of 12 weeks for paid family leave, paid medical leave and paid safe leave
  - Additional 4 weeks available for pregnancy or childbirth complications

You must provide employers no fewer than 30 days' notice if you are able to foresee the need for the leave. If the need for the leave is not foreseeable, you must provide notice as soon as practicable.

# Frequently asked questions

# How do I know if I am eligible for CO PFML?

Any employee is eligible for benefits after they have earned at least \$2,500 in wages within the state of Colorado during the base period (first 4 of the last 5 completed calendar quarters). Note that employees do not need to be a resident of CO.

# How much am I eligible for under CO PFML?

Benefits are calculated based on a formula. The maximum weekly benefit amount is \$1,381.45. You can find out the weekly benefit you are eligible to receive for CO PFML by accessing the FAMLI calculator on <a href="mailto:famili.colorado.gov">famili.colorado.gov</a>. The payment amounts generated by this calculator are estimates only. See the next question about how to file a claim with Sun Life. Please do not file a claim through the state website.
