Animal Farm

Step 1	Submit Your Application	Begin your journey by completing our application form and family questionnaire to help us learn about your child and your family's values. One form per child.
Step 2	Parent and Child Meeting	Visit the school for a relaxed meeting with our teachers to share more about your child and discover Marinela's spirit.
Step 3	Trial Days	Your child joins us for up to three gentle trial days to experience our daily rhythm. For toddlers, visits are shorter one-hour sessions to help them settle in with ease.
Step 4	Enrolment	Once our teachers feel the fit is right, we warmly welcome your family into the Marinela community.

One-Time Registration Fee USD 1,000 per programme	Lunch is included in all full-day programmes. Lunch may be added to half-day programmes at an additional fee. Snacks are provided for all programmes.	
Acceptance Deposit Policy:	A deposit of half of one term's fees is required upon acceptance of a place. This deposit may be applied to the last term's tuition in accordance with the outlined terms.	
Withdrawal Notice:	One full term's notice must be given in writing if withdrawing a pupil. If less than one term's notice is given, a full term's fee will still be charged.	
Tuition Payments:	Tuition Payments are made in three instalments, due by: 1st August 2026, 1st December 2026, and 1st April 2027. 10% Discount for Siblings may apply.	
Short-Term Enrolment Fee:	Families enrolling for less than the full academic year (3 terms) may do so. Term tuition is charged at one third of the annual fee, plus an additional USD 2,500 per term. This applies to all programmes and to both International and Barbadian families.
