## 4. Aims and objectives

### **Our Aims and Objectives**

Our assessments are designed to inform diagnostic formulations where appropriate, including formal diagnoses of neurodevelopmental conditions such as ADHD and Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD), in line with NICE guidance and established clinical protocols. All diagnostic decisions are made by qualified clinicians contracted by Insight Psychological Assessments.

At Insight Psychological Assessments we are committed to providing comprehensive, evidence-based psychological assessments for individuals of all ages, seeking clarity and support for a wide range of developmental, cognitive and emotional challenges. We offer individuals detailed, accurate, and compassionate assessments that inform effective treatment strategies and improve overall well-being. We aim to enable clients to access the insights and support they need to lead fulfilling lives, by providing precise, tailored assessments that highlight an individual's strengths, challenges, and opportunities for growth.

### **Our Services**

Our primary client group comprises children and young people who are in foster care, under local authority care, or involved in adoption and kinship care arrangements. We also assess adults where appropriate. Referrals are received from local authorities, independent fostering agencies, education services, and private individuals. We specialise in offering a broad range of psychological assessments, each designed to meet the unique needs of our clients.

Services are delivered via secure online platforms or at suitable community venues, educational settings, or clients' homes. Insight Psychological Assessments does not currently operate from clinical premises.

All assessments are delivered within a safeguarding framework consistent with "Working Together to Safeguard Children" (2023) and the organisation's internal safeguarding policy. Informed consent is obtained for each assessment from the person holding parental responsibility (usually the local authority for children in care). The child's wishes and understanding are always considered and assent is sought wherever possible.

### **Neurodevelopmental Assessments:**

These focus on identifying developmental disorders such as learning disabilities, developmental delays, and other conditions that affect cognitive, emotional, and behavioural growth. These assessments help in understanding a client's developmental trajectory and informing tailored educational or therapeutic interventions.

**ADHD Assessments:**

We offer comprehensive evaluations for Attention-Deficit/Hyperactivity Disorder (ADHD) to help individuals, parents, and educators understand the signs, symptoms, and impact of ADHD on daily functioning. Our ADHD assessments incorporate input from multiple sources and a variety of diagnostic tools to ensure a holistic understanding of the individual's needs.

**Cognitive Assessments:**

Are used to evaluate an individual's cognitive strengths and challenges, including intelligence, memory, problem-solving skills, and executive functions. These assessments provide valuable insights into cognitive performance and guide interventions to improve learning, and daily life functioning.

**Psychological Trauma Assessments:**

Our assessments aim to create a clear understanding of how ASD manifests in an individual's life, providing essential information for educational planning, social support, and intervention strategies.

**Forensic Psychological Assessments:**

We offer forensic risk assessments when there are concerns about harmful or risky behaviours. This may include aggression, sexually inappropriate behaviour or vulnerability to exploitation. Using structured professional judgement tools such as SAVRY and AIM3, we assess areas of vulnerability and strength, and evaluate potential risks in context. Each assessment includes a comprehensive report with tailored recommendations, providing a clear, evidence-based plan for risk management and support across care, education and community settings.

**Our Approach**

All clinicians delivering assessments on behalf of Insight Psychological Assessments Ltd. are appropriately qualified, registered with their relevant professional bodies (e.g. GMC, NMC, HCPC), and work within their professional codes of conduct and the organisation's clinical governance policy. Supervision and reflective practice are mandatory, and clinical notes are stored in compliance with data protection law.

Each assessment is individualised, considering the person's unique history, experiences, and goals.
