Bag Policy and Prohibited Items

To keep entry safe and fast, please review this before you arrive. All bags are checked at the main doors every day.

Bags

1. One bag per guest, no larger than 17 by 12 by 8 inches. This is about the size of a standard backpack.
2. Every bag is checked at the main doors, every day. Plan a few extra minutes.
3. Bag check is at the main doors only. There is no bag storage inside the Arena or Concourse, so bring only what you need.
4. Medical bags and diaper bags are welcome, may be larger, and will be screened separately.

Welcome to Bring

1. A refillable water bottle, empty or filled. Water stations are available on site.
2. Your phone and everyday personal items.
3. Anything you need for accessibility or medical reasons.

Please Leave at Home

1. Weapons of any kind, including firearms, knives, and anything that looks like a weapon. Weapons are not allowed anywhere in the building, including for guests with a concealed carry permit.
2. Self-defense sprays such as pepper spray or mace.
3. Illegal drugs and marijuana in any form.
4. Outside food. Please eat before you arrive or enjoy our on-site concessions, food trucks, and the many restaurants within walking distance. Items for medical or dietary needs are welcome.
5. Outside alcohol.
6. Fireworks, explosives, and flammable items.
7. Smoke or fog machines.
8. Glass containers.
9. Coolers and large outside food or drink containers.
10. Drones and remote-control devices.
11. Wheeled items such as skateboards, scooters, hoverboards, roller skates, shoes with wheels, wagons, and rolling carts. Wheelchairs and mobility devices are always welcome.
12. Selfie sticks, tripods, monopods, and large camera equipment.
13. Flash photography and professional cameras with detachable lenses. Phone and basic point-and-shoot photos are fine.
14. Air horns, whistles, megaphones, and other noisemakers.
15. Laser pointers.
16. Large signs, banners, or poles.

17. Pets or animals, except trained service animals.

18. Any item that is illegal or disrupts the event.

Good to Know

1. The Anaheim Convention Center is non-smoking and non-vaping indoors. Smoking and vaping are allowed only in designated outdoor areas.
2. This list is not exhaustive. Security may make adjustments for safety.
3. If you arrive with a prohibited item, you will be asked to return it to your vehicle or dispose of it. We cannot store items for you, so please plan ahead.
4. Accommodations for disabilities and medical needs are available. Ask any staff member or at check-in.
