Transportation

NOTE: Parents living in Maple Valley/Ravensdale/Black Diamond area may drop their students off at Lake Retreat. We ask that you drop them off by 4:00 so they can arrive with the other New Life students. The parking lots is very small. Plan to drive through and drop them off. Our leaders will be there to greet them and help them to their cabins. Even if you are driving your student to Lake Retreat, you still need to check-in at Bag Drop on Sunday, June 28.

Mandatory Bag Drop for Parents & Campers DAY BEFORE CAMP

- All students must bring their camping gear (sleeping bag, pillow, suitcase, etc.) and check it in. We will bag it and put your student's name on it. They will pick up their tagged bag when they arrive at camp.
- REMINDER: NO CELL PHONE OR ELECTRONICS
- **MEDICATIONS:** Parents, please put all your student's medication in a clear, gallon Ziplock bag with their name on it in permanent marker. Medications must be in the original containers with instructions. Students are not allowed to keep any medication with them in their cabin. These will be turned in to the camp nurse at Bag Drop.
- Students will receive their cabin assignments at Bag Drop.
- Students can make requests to be in cabins with their friends. Requests can be made at the time of payment (We will do our best to accommodate. We keep campers in the same grade together as best we can.)
- Students will receive their camp bracelet that is their "ticket" to get on the bus on Sunday at Bag Drop.
- NEW FOR 2026. We are giving all parents an opportunity to write their students a "secret" note. We will collect these and discreetly give them to their cabin leader to hand out on Wednesday at camp. Clearly mark your student's first and last name on the outside of the envelope. 😊
