Technology Policy

- All students must bring their camping gear (sleeping bag, pillow, suitcase, etc.) and check it in. We will bag it and put your student's name on it. They will pick up their tagged bag when they arrive at camp.
- REMINDER: NO CELL PHONE OR ELECTRONICS

- Put all your student’s medication in a clear, gallon Ziplock bag with their name on it: last name first. Turn in all medication to the camp nurse with completed [Medication Form](#). Medications must be in the original containers with instructions. Students are not allowed to keep any medication with them in their cabin except life saving epi-pens.
- Students will receive their cabin assignments at Bag Drop.
- Students can make requests to be in cabins with their friends. Requests can be made at the time of payment. We will do our best to accommodate.
- Students will receive their camp bracelet that is their “ticket” to get on the bus on Wednesday morning.
- NEW FOR 2026. We are giving all parents an opportunity to write their students a “secret” note. We will collect these and discreetly give them to their cabin leader to hand out during camp. Clearly mark your student’s first and last name. Letters and packages mailed to camp do not usually make it there on time to be delivered. So have it ready at Bag Drop and we will deliver it for you!

2026 Summer Camp Packing List

WHAT TO BRING: Mark all belongings. Camp will not be responsible for stolen, lost or damaged articles left at camp. Remind your students to be sure to check Lost & Found before they leave.

*******Refillable water bottle with their name on it *******We cannot emphasize how important this is! Dehydration and heat stroke are very real in temperatures over 100 degrees.

FAQ: Will my student need money? Silver Lake has a merchandise store and there will be 2026 camp themed merchandise. The theme is “GTG” Glory to Glory. Sweatshirts, hats, and T-shirts will be available to purchase.

Silver Lake also has a fabulous Cafe’ and Coffee Shop in the Lounge above the dining room. The Café is open during afternoon free time and again after the evening chapel service. Students can use

cash, credit cards, Google Pay and Apple Pay. Be sure your students know how much money they have to spend and how to keep it safe.
