NO MANDATORY BAG DROP for Jr. High Camp

We are trying something new. We are asking parents to drop off their students on Monday, June 29 beginning at 3:30 pm. All students need to be dropped off by 4:00
The parking lot is very small. Plan to drive through and drop them off. Our leaders will be there to greet them and help them to their cabins.

- All students must bring their camping gear: sleeping bag, pillow, suitcase, and medication, etc to camp drop off.
- REMINDER: NO CELL PHONE OR ELECTRONICS. No wi-fi devices.
- **MEDICATIONS:** Parents, please put all your student's medication in a clear, gallon Ziplock bag with their name on it in permanent marker. Medications must be in the original containers with instructions. Students are not allowed to keep any

medication with them in their cabin. These will be turned in to the Medication Table at drop off at Lake Retreat.

- Students can make requests to be in cabins with their friends. Requests can be made at the time of payment.
