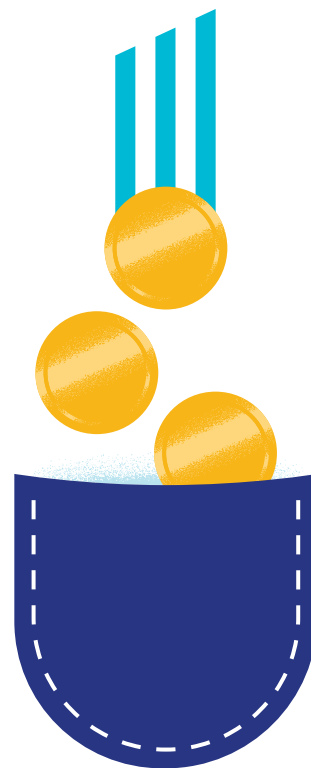

- Breast MRI
- Breast ultrasound
- Chest X-ray
- Colonoscopy
- Complete blood count
- Doppler screening for abdominal aorta
- Doppler screening for carotids
- Doppler screening for peripheral vascular disease
- Echocardiogram
- Electrocardiogram
- Endoscopy
- Fasting blood glucose test
- Fasting plasma glucose (FPG)
- Flexible sigmoidoscopy
- Hemocult stool analysis
- Hemoglobin A1C (HbA1c)
- HPV testing
- Lipid panel
- Mammography
- Monoclonal antibody therapy
- Pap smear
- Serum cholesterol (HDL and LDL)
- Stress test on a bicycle or treadmill

- ✓ The benefit will only be paid for 1 test each calendar year, regardless of the test results
- ✓ This benefit is paid in addition to any other payments you and/or your covered spouse may receive under the CIPP policy
