

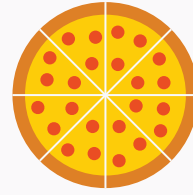
# Pico's Pizza Panic

Pico's eyes lit up as he read a message on his tablet

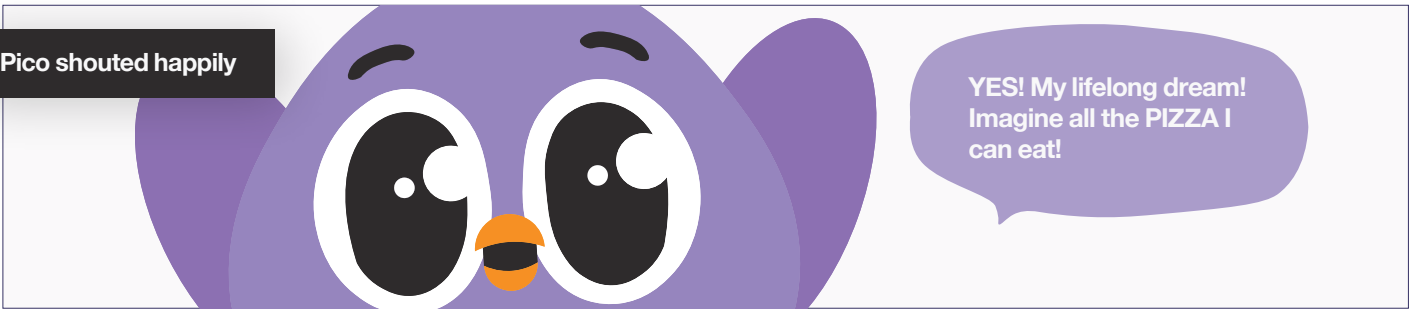

You've won FREE PIZZA FOR LIFE!



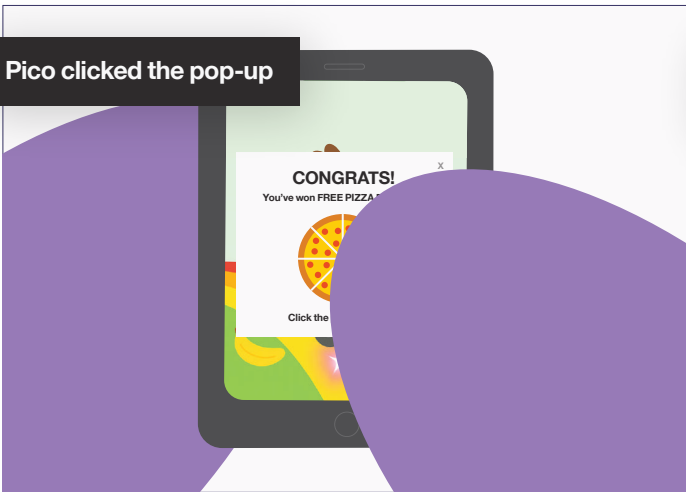
Click the pizza to claim!

can eat!

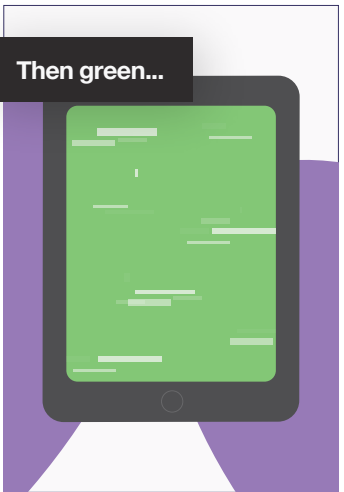
Pico clicked the pop-up



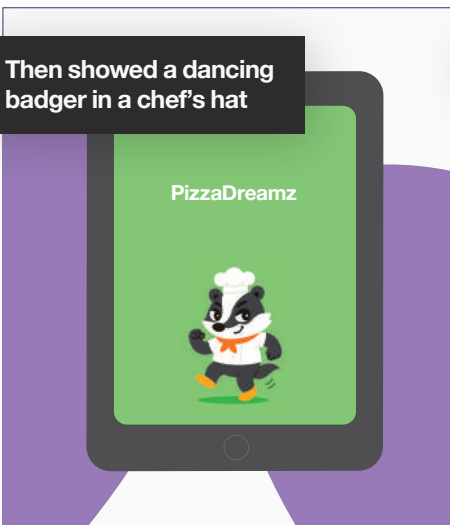
The screen flashed red...



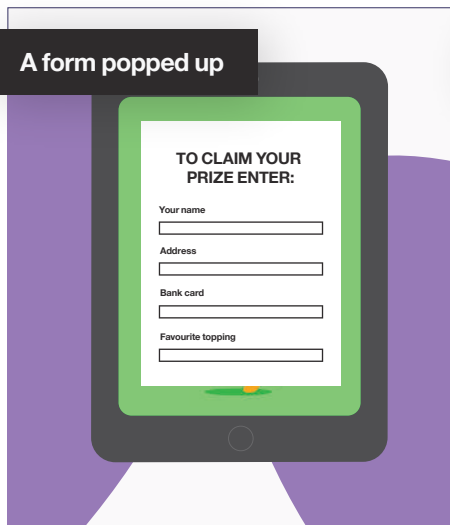
Then green...



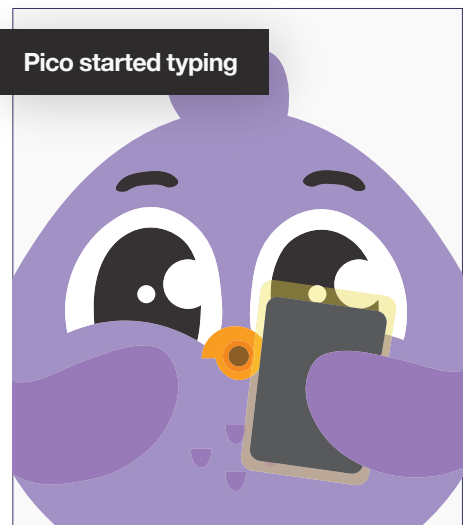
Then showed a dancing badger in a chef's hat



A form popped up

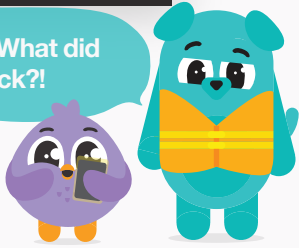


Pico started typing

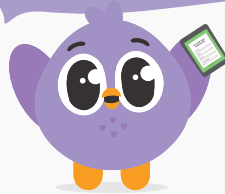


Suddenly, Moxo burst in wearing a lifejacket
