Middle of Year STAR Assessment

Your scholar will be bringing home their STAR assessment reports for Reading and Math.

- Reading: Look for the IRL (Instructional Reading Level). This indicates the grade level your child is currently reading at and can help guide appropriate books and supports.
- Math: Look at the reported math level (Levels 1–4). This shows your child's current proficiency band in math.

Please review the bar graph on the report to see your scholar's growth from the beginning of the year to the middle of the year. If you have any questions or would like suggestions for ways to support learning at home, please contact your scholar's teacher. Thank you for your partnership!

Updated Electronics Policy (reminder)

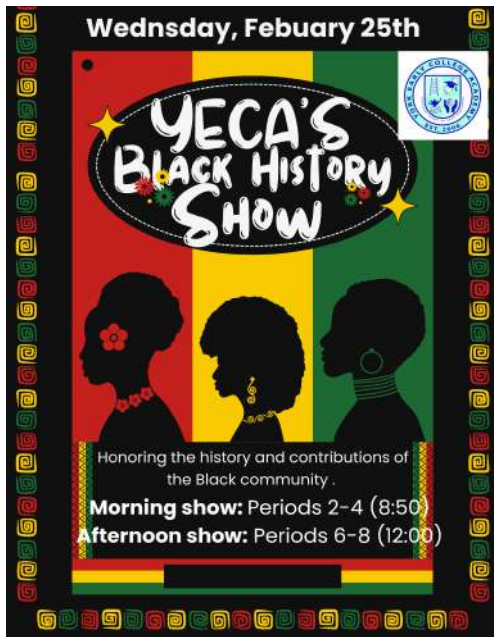


11th and 12th Grade College Program

You can reset your student password easily by following these instructions:

1. Click on **Settings**.
2. Click on **Student Password**.
3. Select the child whose password you want to update.
4. Enter a new password. Your password must:
 - Contain between 8–32 characters.
 - Contain at least one number (0–9).
 - Contain at least one lowercase letter (a–z).
 - Contain at least one uppercase letter (A–Z).
5. Retype the new password.
6. Click on **Save**.
7. That's it! Your password has been reset.
