(Reminder) Summer Rising: Message from Dr. Tosin, Director of GRYC

The Summer Rising application will open on **March 3, 2026**. The Summer Rising program for middle school students (Grades 6–8) will run from **July 1, 2026 through August 7, 2026 (Monday-Friday)**. **If you would like your child to participate in Summer Rising this year, please log into your MySchools portal (Summer Rising) and complete the application as soon as possible.** The application deadline is **March 27, 2026**, and no applications will be accepted after this date.

- When completing your child's application, please be sure to select **three choices**. Your **first choice should be York Early College Academy (hosted by Greater Ridgewood Youth Council, Inc.)**. You may then select two additional schools as your second and third choices.
- Summer Rising offer letters will be released on **April 21, 2026**. The deadline to accept your child's offer is **May 5, 2026**.
- Summer Rising placements are determined through a **lottery-based system**.

You can reset your student password easily by following these instructions:

1. Click on **Settings**.

2. Click on **Student Password**.
3. Select the child whose password you want to update.
4. Enter a new password. Your password must:
 - Contain between 8–32 characters.
 - Contain at least one number (0–9).
 - Contain at least one lowercase letter (a–z).
 - Contain at least one uppercase letter (A–Z).
5. Retype the new password.
6. Click on **Save**.
7. That's it! Your password has been reset.
