The Karuk Tribe requests proposals for the following Scope of Work required for provision of Self Defense and Fitness instruction for community members in Orleans, Happy Camp and Yreka.

Task One - Group Design and Curriculum

Contractor will coordinate with the Missing and Murdered Indigenous People's (MMIP) program to schedule weekly visits to Orleans, Happy Camp and Yreka. Contractor will coordinate with MMIP to plan group sizes, and assess needs of group, including equipment needs.

Task Two – Provision of 12 weeks of Self Defense/Fitness classes

Contractor is responsible for scheduling, preparation, and facilitation of 12 weeks of Self Defense Courses, in person. Classes will be conducted one day a week in Happy Camp and one day a week in Orleans and one day a week in Yreka, for one hour each,.

Any safety gear required beyond mats (which will be provided by the Karuk Tribe) must be supplied by contractor.

Contractor must have Martial Arts and Self Defense Instructors Liability Insurance for and be liable for coverage of the following:

All contracts that exceed \$2,500.00 shall be subject to a two percent (2%) Tribal Employment Rights Fee in accordance with the TERO Ordinance.

If applicable, construction contracts in excess of \$2,000, when required by Federal grant program legislation, are subject to compliance with the Davis-Bacon Act (40 USC 276a to a-7) as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR part 5).

A background check consisting of employment history, professional references, and criminal check may be conducted. Applicants will be required to pass the background check in accordance to the Karuk Tribe Personnel Policy and Federal/State/Tribal requirements.
