A Foundation for Sustained Recovery

The Karuk Tribal Transitional Home Program is specifically designed to support Karuk tribal male adults who are deeply committed to their recovery journey and are seeking a stable, sober living environment.

 **Important Note:** This program is **not a homeless shelter**. Its primary purpose is to offer a safe, structured, and accountable living space for men serious about maintaining their sobriety and successfully transitioning back into the community.

Program Eligibility Criteria

To be eligible for the program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- **Identity & Age:** Must be a male member of the Karuk Tribe, aged 18 years or older.
 - **Verified Sobriety:** Must have maintained sobriety for at least **30 days**, verified by a certificate from a recognized treatment facility.
 - **Employment Focus:** Must demonstrate a willingness and readiness to work, either part-time or full-time.

We provide critical support during the vital stages of recovery, helping participants build the necessary life skills, community connections, and stable environment required for long-term sobriety.
