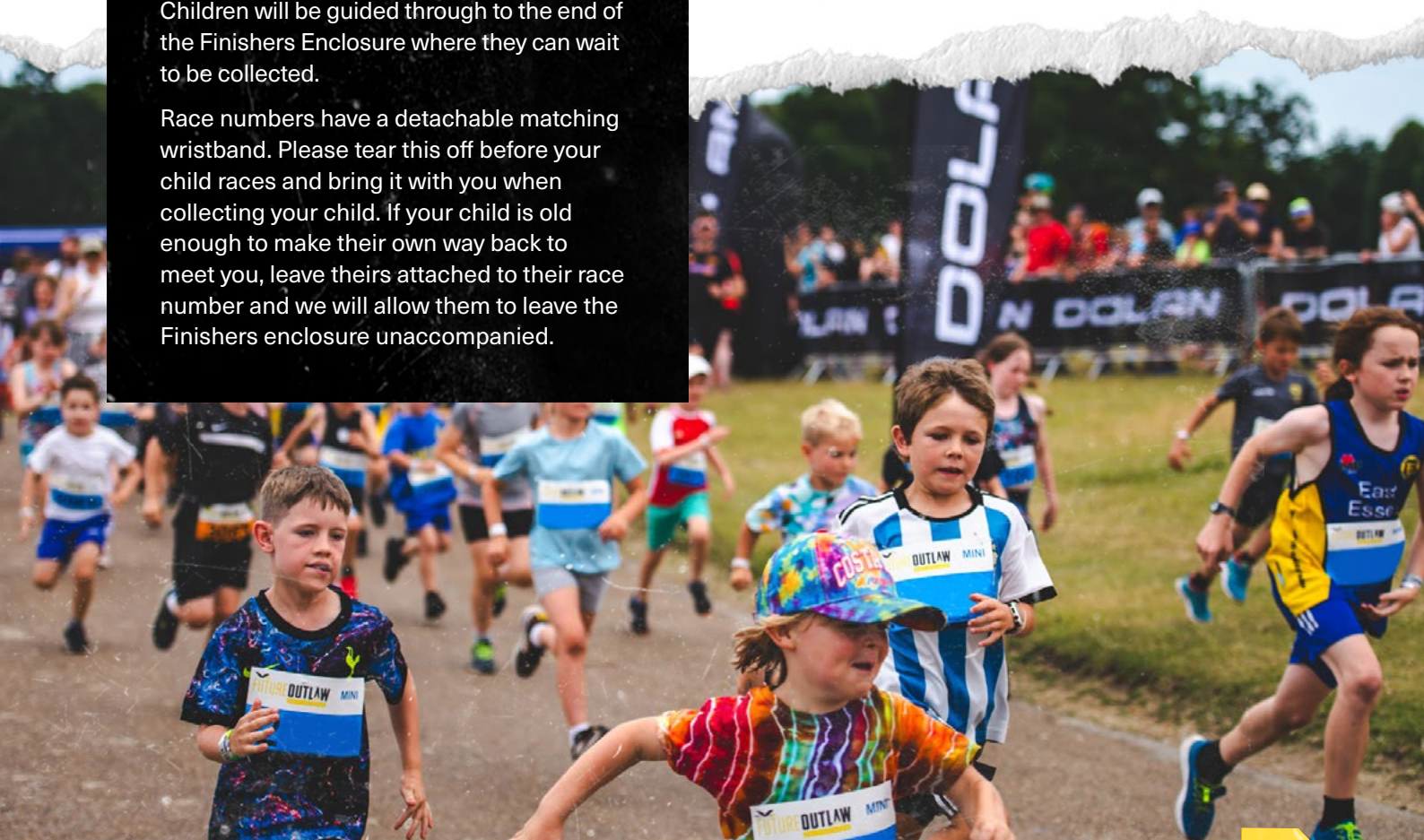
IMPORTANT: PARENT/CHILD WRISTBANDS

Due to the layout, parents cannot meet up with children immediately at the Finish Line. Children will be guided through to the end of the Finishers Enclosure where they can wait to be collected.

Race numbers have a detachable matching wristband. Please tear this off before your child races and bring it with you when collecting your child. If your child is old enough to make their own way back to meet you, leave theirs attached to their race number and we will allow them to leave the Finishers enclosure unaccompanied.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

We have a professional medical team on site, if you or your child require medical assistance at any point please ask an event marshal.

DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

The main entrance for the public, cars and small coaches to Holkham Park, the Hall and other attractions, is via the north gates of the estate on Park Road.

You can pre-book a parking pass for £6.50. This can be done by going to the confirmation email from Lets Do This and clicking on the 'manage booking' option.

BRIEFING AND RULES

The rules are very simple, have fun and smile on your way round! There will be a short warm up and a briefing just before the race, so everyone knows where they are going. Parents are welcome to run with children if they wish - just make sure you can keep up!

BRIEFING AND START

To Collect pre-purchased race numbers please go to the Saturday Events desk in the Registration Tent in the Event Village. On the day entries can be purchased from the On-The-Day/Enquiries desk. Please visit our team between 13:00 and 14:45.

Race numbers for Minis (4-14 years) will be blue and Juniors (8-15 years) will be Orange. The race number has a timing chip stuck to the back of it. Please do not bend this as it could stop it working. There is a detachable wristband which parents should take off and wear if their child is too young to make their way back to them unaccompanied, so our volunteers can make sure children are leaving with the correct person.

Please bring safety pins or a race belt to attach the race number to your front, you must wear it at all times during the event, do not fold or tear it.

Please write emergency contact details and any medical information on the back of the number, with a large MC on the front if there is a medical information.



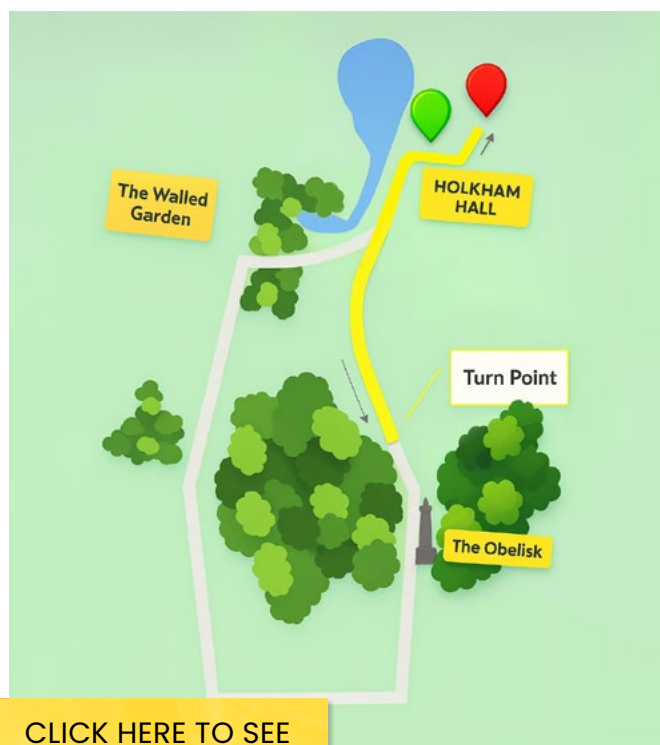
THE ROUTE

THE ROUTE

Both the Mini and the Junior events begin in front of Holkham Hall and finish on the famous Orange Carpet. The route will be sign posted and marshals will direct your child around the route.

MINI | 1.2M

The Minis will complete a 1.2 mile out and back loop which takes them up towards the Obelisk before turning back to head to the finish chute.

JUNIOR | 2.4M

The juniors will complete a 2.4 mile loop, heading up past the Obelisk before turning right to run around the farm tracks towards the Walled Garden and then heading back down towards the Hall and the finish chute. There will be water at the turn before the Obelisk.

MEETING UP AFTER THE RACE

Family and friends can watch competitors run down the finish line from the Event Village before heading to Family Collection Point at the exit to the finish area. Please don't delay in collecting your children - we don't want anyone being worried and it is also important that we can allow our volunteer Marshals to finish on time.

Participants will cross the line and collect their medal before being guided to the exit of the finish area.

- **If the wristband has been detached from the Race Number** - Children will be held in the Family Collection Point area until an adult with the matching wristband arrives to collect them.
- **If the wristband has not been detached from the Race Number** - Children will be allowed to make their own way back to family.
