IMPORTANT: PARENT/CHILD WRISTBANDS

Due to the layout, parents cannot meet up with children immediately at the Finish Line. Children will be guided up the staircase to the Family Collection Point inside the Main Building, where they can wait to meet the parents.

Race numbers have a detachable matching wristband. Please tear this off before your child races and bring it with you when collecting your child. If your child is old enough to make their own way back to meet you, leave their attached to their race number and we will allow them to leave the Finishers enclosure unaccompanied.

MEDICAL SUPPORT

We have a professional medical team on site, if you require medical assistance at any point please ask an event marshal.

DIRECTIONS AND PARKING

The venue uses an ANPR system pre-purchase parking via parkpcm.co.uk using code **4455**.

Throughout the weekend multiple car parks will be available; Please head to the what three words address: **///moral.ropes.robe** where you will be directed to the next available car park.

REGISTRATION

To collect pre-purchased race numbers please go to the Saturday Events desk in the Registration Tent in the Event Village. On the day entries can be purchased from the registration area. Please visit our team between 13:00 and 14:45.

The race number has a timing chip stuck to the back of it. Please do not bend this as it could stop it working. Please bring safety pins or a race belt to attach the race number to your front, you must wear it at all times during the event, do not fold or tear it.

Please write emergency contact details and any medical information on the back of the number, with a large MC on the front if there is a medical information.

BRIEFING AND RULES

The rules are very simple, have fun and smile on your way round! There will be a short warm up and a briefing just before the race, so everyone knows where they are going. Parents are welcome to run with children if they wish - just make sure you can keep up!



THE ROUTE

Both events begin in front of the Grandstand and finish on the famous Outlaw orange carpet. The route will be signposted and marshals will direct children round the course.

Participants will gather at the 'To Transition' gantry in the Event Village at 14:50 before being led down to the start line.

Listen out to the commentary team for directions. After a short warm up, the Juniors will be briefed first, then they will begin as one group.

The Minis event will start approximately 3-5 mins later. The route is an anti-clockwise loop, 1 lap for the Minis and 2 laps for the Juniors.

After completing the first lap, the 1.2 mile mini runners need to take the left to the finish gantry, 2.4 mile Junior runners bear right to do their second lap. There will be a lead and tail biker on the course as well as our marshals who will help to guide you - remember to smile when you see them!

A drink station with water will be available to at the start of the second lap for the Junior race. Drinks will be in the finish area where runners will collect their finishers medal. After your race, head up to the Event Village where you can take your photo in front of our results display screens.

AFTER THE RACE

MEETING UP AFTER THE RACE

Family and friends can watch competitors run down the finish line from the Granstand area before heading to Family Collection Point inside the building. Please don't delay in collecting your children - we don't want anyone being worried and it is also important that we can allow our volunteer Marshals to finish on time.

Participants will cross the line and collect their medal before being guided up the metal staircase to the Reception Floor of the main building. Spectators will come into the building via the main doors to Reception and turn right to meet up with their runner.

If the wristband has been detached from the Race Number - Children will be held in the Family Collection Point area until an adult with the matching wristband arrives to collect them.

If the wristband has not been detached from the Race Number - Children will be allowed to make their own way back to family.
