Production Area: Vineyards located in the province of Vicenza, Italy.

Grape Varieties: Cabernet Franc and Cabernet Sauvignon

Harvest: The grapes are hand-harvested around mid-September.

Maximum Yield: 8 tons per hectare.

Tasting Notes: Ruby red in color, this wine has an intense and enveloping nose, with fruity notes of strawberry and red berries, complemented by subtle toasted nuances. On the palate, it is fresh and moderately tannic, well-balanced and elegant.

Alcohol Content: 13% vol.

Aging Potential: Best enjoyed young.
