- ✦ Do I need to have any previous drone experience to take this course? No.
- ✦ How big is the drone and how much does it weigh? It fits in a gas mask-sized pouch and weighs less than 5 lbs., with grenade attached.
- ✦ How long does it take to arm and fly the drone? After initial training, and starting with the drone in a pouch, most personnel can arm, deploy, launch, and kill a target within 1,000 meters in a about two minutes.
