












Joining the Partnership means...


Demonstrating and contributing to best practice

Adopt the Skills Builder Framework

The Skills Builder Framework breaks down each essential skill into teachable steps, supporting progress for individuals of all ages and at all stages in their education or career. The Framework was developed by Skills Builder with the Careers & Enterprise Company, Gatsby Foundation, Business in the Community, EY foundation, the CBI and CIPD. It provides a shared language and outcomes for everyone in the Partnership.



Contribute to lasting change

Refined over a decade, the Skills Builder Principles outline best practice in teaching essential skills. As a Partnership, we *all* contribute to ensuring that *every* individual has the chance to learn about essential skills, to reflect on theirs, to practice them, and to build them further.

Joining the Partnership

The membership offer has been designed for impact organisations who want to be part of a movement to build the essential skills of everyone. Each organisation brings their own expertise, but we all contribute to a bigger goal.

A flexible menu

Our membership model is deliberately flexible, so you can get what you want to out of it. Four key things you could do are to:

Align with the Framework

We work with our partners to help individuals develop their essential skills through your programmes.

This might mean drawing out more opportunities to build essential skills in your programmes, or adapting or creating new ones.

Demonstrate your impact

- Share assessment tools
- Measure collective impact
- Support funding bids

We work with partners to use the Framework and impact measurement tools as part of new or existing impact measurement systems.

This can help to demonstrate your programme's effectiveness in building essential skills to educators, funders, or employers.

Train your team

- Upskill your own team
- · Support your facilitators
- Share best practice

We work with partners to train their teams to support you to build the essential skills of your beneficiaries.

This gives your whole team scope for professional development, supporting your journey to embed and enhance essential skill development into your provision.

When partners have integrated the Skills Builder approach into their programmes, they are awarded an Impact Level and added to the Directory.

The Directory is an online, searchable catalogue of all programmes that have been approved as ways to support individuals to build their essential skills.

Included in Membership

Your membership of the Skills Builder Partnership includes a wide range of tools and resources, as well as networking and support.



Tools and resources

All of our partners can use any of the resources we've developed to support their programmes:



Skills Builder Hub: Lots of short lessons to teach essential skills, as well as formative assessment tools.



Interactive Framework Tool: Full breakdowns of how to build each skill step,



Skills Builder Benchmark: Allows individuals to self-assess their own essential skills. (Admin licences available at cost).



Guides, assets and materials: Easily adaptable materials and guides to build into your programme, including video assets.



Support and network

We also provide a lot of support and networking opportunities to get as much as possible out of your membership:

- Introductory webinars: Regular opportunities to learn about how to use your membership, and meet other partners.
- **Kick-off and support session:** A session designed for you and your team to work out your priorities for your membership.
- **Webinars and forums:** Regular opportunities to attend masterclasses, and to network with your peers in our forums.
- Programmes in Directory: When your programme has achieved one of our Impact Levels, it can be included in the public Directory which shares approved programmes with the world.



Bespoke support options

Alongside Membership, we know that some of our partners also value having more support to fully embed the approach, train their teams, or develop a new offer.

Each additional day of bespoke support is priced at £600 per day, including preparation and delivery. Options include:



Reviewing current provision: We can either audit this ourselves and make suggestions, or we can upskill your programme team and review your programmes together.



Measuring impact: We can run a spotlight workshop to review your provision or programme's impact measurement process, and how the Skills Builder Framework can support.



Resource creation workshop: We can run a workshop to upskill your team on Skills Builder pedagogy and practical tools available to support you in developing new resources.



Developing resources: We can also create brand new essential skills resources if you would like to commission us to do so.



Train the Trainer: We can train your team on the Skills Builder approach, and build their confidence and ability to build the essential skills of your beneficiaries.
