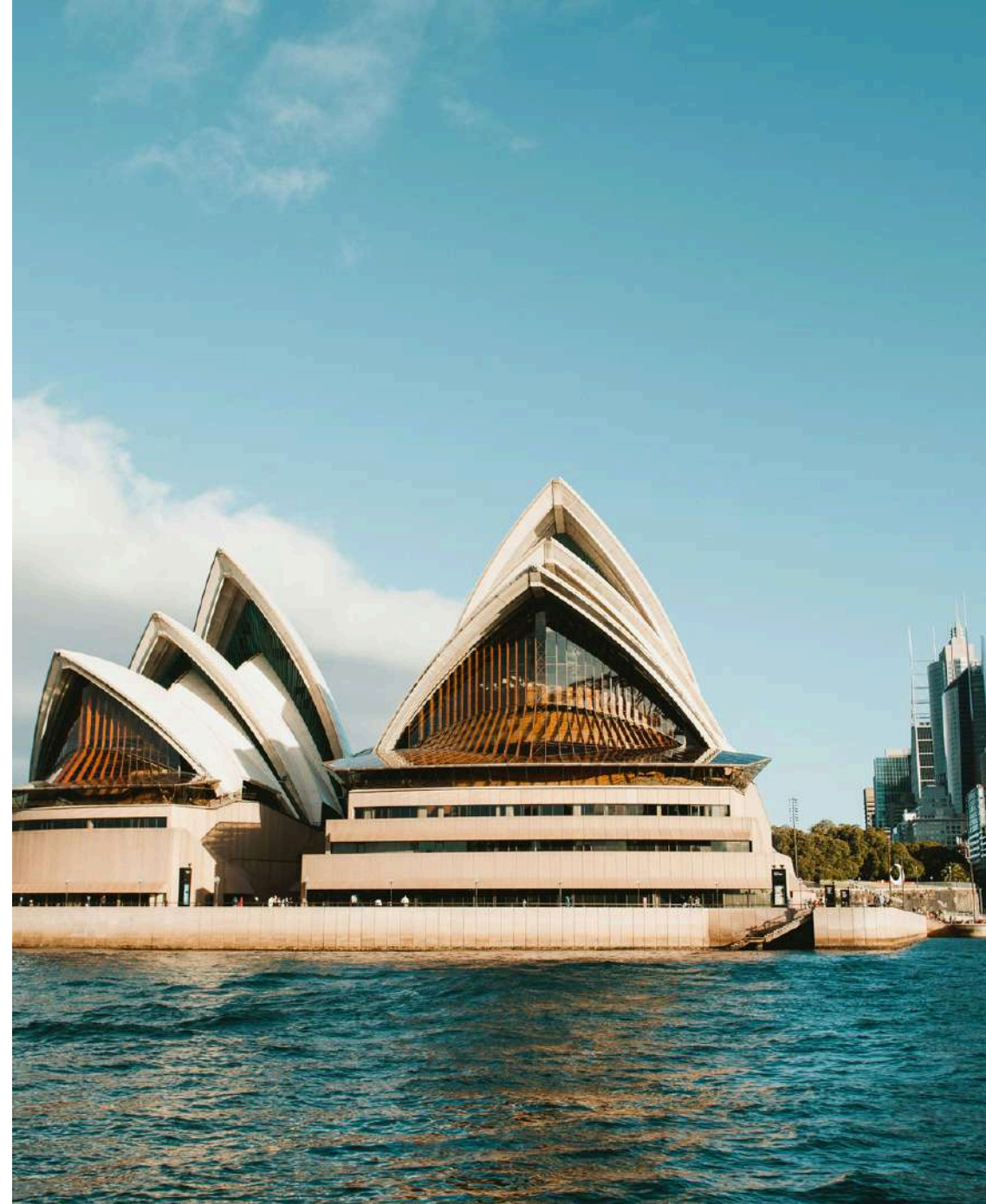

You'll explore what it means to study and work in law — analysing real cases, debating legal principles, and learning how justice is delivered. Through practical experiences, discussions, and collaboration, you'll build the analytical and communication skills essential for success in future legal and civic careers.

Project Based Sessions

You'll explore the law by applying it to real-world challenges. Sessions are designed to help you interpret legislation, analyse evidence, and present reasoned arguments. Working in small teams, you'll simulate court scenarios, discuss ethical dilemmas, and practise skills used by lawyers, judges, and advocates. These activities connect theoretical understanding to practical skills, developing confidence in critical thinking, collaboration, and legal reasoning through hands-on, scenario-based learning.

Legal Systems and the Rule of Law

Discover how the rule of law underpins fairness and justice in society. You'll explore how the Australian legal system functions within the broader common law tradition and how laws are made, interpreted, and enforced. Through group activities, you'll practise identifying legal issues and applying reasoning to examples. This topic builds your understanding of how legal frameworks protect rights and maintain order in societies.





Criminal Law and Justice in Action

Learn how criminal law balances accountability and fairness. You'll examine how crimes are defined, prosecuted, and defended, and analyse real or simulated cases to explore how justice is achieved. Interactive discussions and exercises will highlight the roles of lawyers, judges, and juries. This topic helps you understand the principles of criminal responsibility and how evidence, ethics, and advocacy interact in the courtroom.

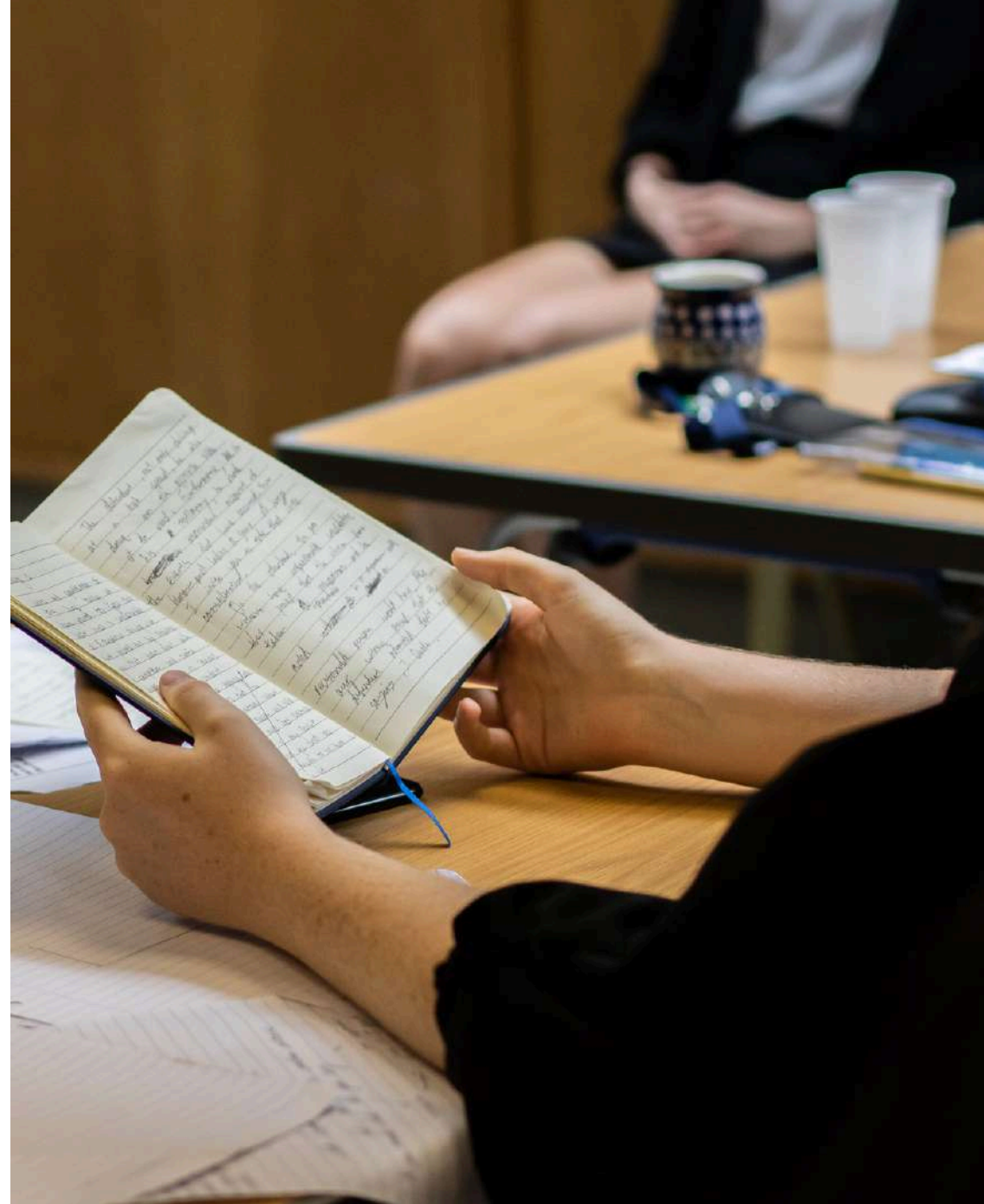

Human Rights and Social Justice

Explore how law protects human dignity and equality. You'll study key human rights principles and apply them to real-world issues such as privacy, discrimination, and freedom of expression. Through debate and case analysis, you'll examine how lawyers advocate for justice in both local and global contexts. This topic develops your ability to analyse ethical dilemmas and think critically about law's role in social change.



Contract and Commercial Law in Practice

Understand how legal agreements form the foundation of business and everyday interactions. You'll explore how contracts are created, interpreted, and enforced, using realistic examples to see how law supports fairness and reliability in transactions. Practical exercises will help you apply core principles, such as offer, acceptance, and consideration, to problem-solving scenarios. This topic also builds commercial awareness, a key skill for aspiring legal professionals.

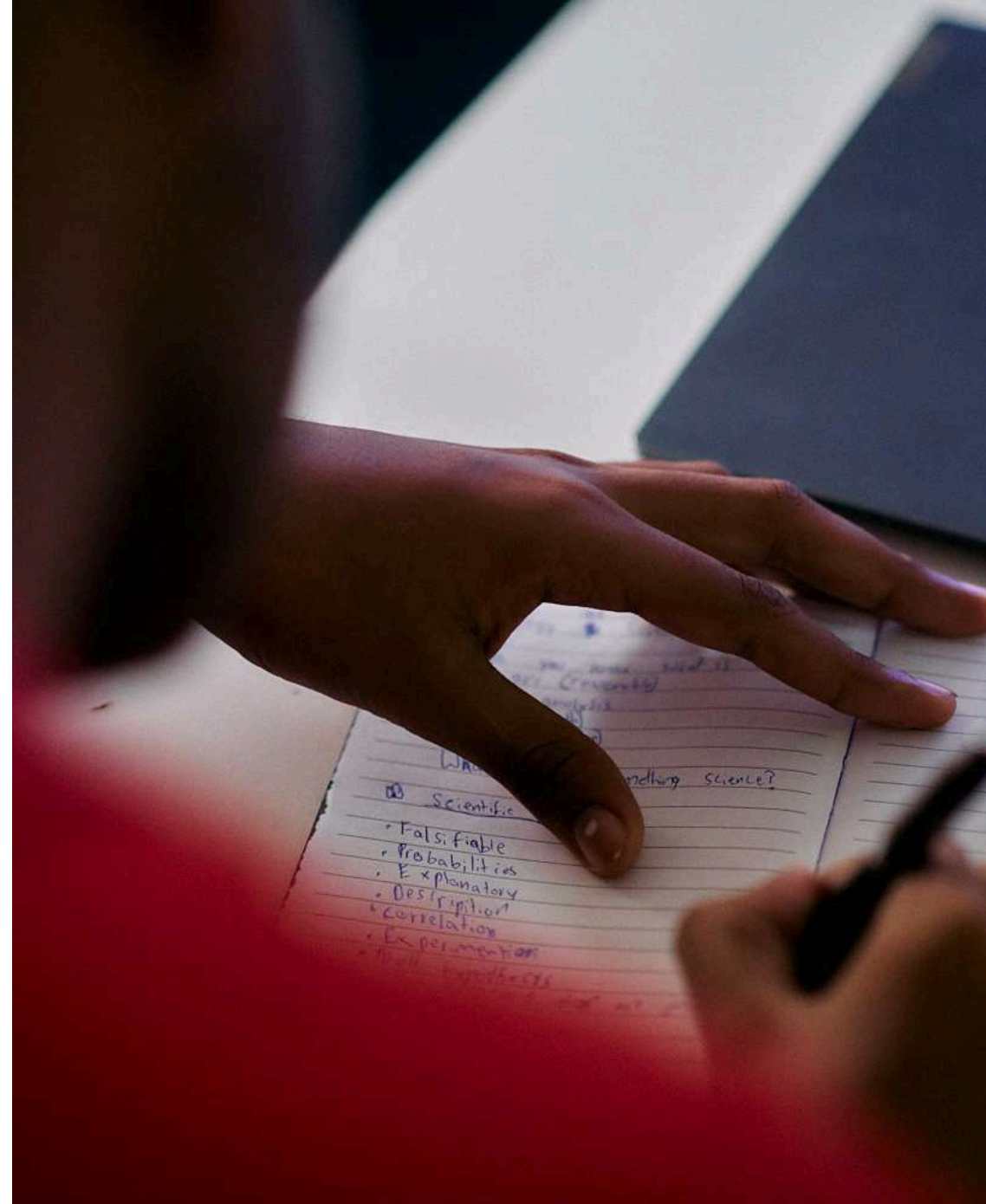
Legal Ethics and Professional Conduct

Investigate the ethical responsibilities of lawyers and legal professionals. You'll discuss scenarios involving client confidentiality, conflicts of interest, and public duty. Through group discussions, you'll apply ethical frameworks to difficult decisions, considering how personal integrity underpins trust in the legal system. This topic builds professional awareness and moral reasoning, essential for anyone pursuing a career in law or public service.



Advocacy and Communication in Law

Practise how lawyers use advocacy to argue cases and persuade audiences. You'll prepare and present arguments in mock settings, developing clarity, confidence, and analytical reasoning. This topic also explores how communication and negotiation are essential beyond the courtroom, in mediation, corporate law, and policymaking. By combining teamwork and individual reflection, you'll gain practical skills that prepare you for both study and future legal careers.





Career Development Plan

Throughout the programme, every student will work on an individual project focused on shaping their future career pathway. This project is designed to bring together the knowledge and insights gained during the programme, including an understanding of the subject area, the industry, and the variety of opportunities it offers. Guided by their own interests and passions, students will consider potential directions for study and work. With support from tutors during one-to-one sessions, participants will develop their project into a clear and personalised plan, which they will present at the end of the programme.
