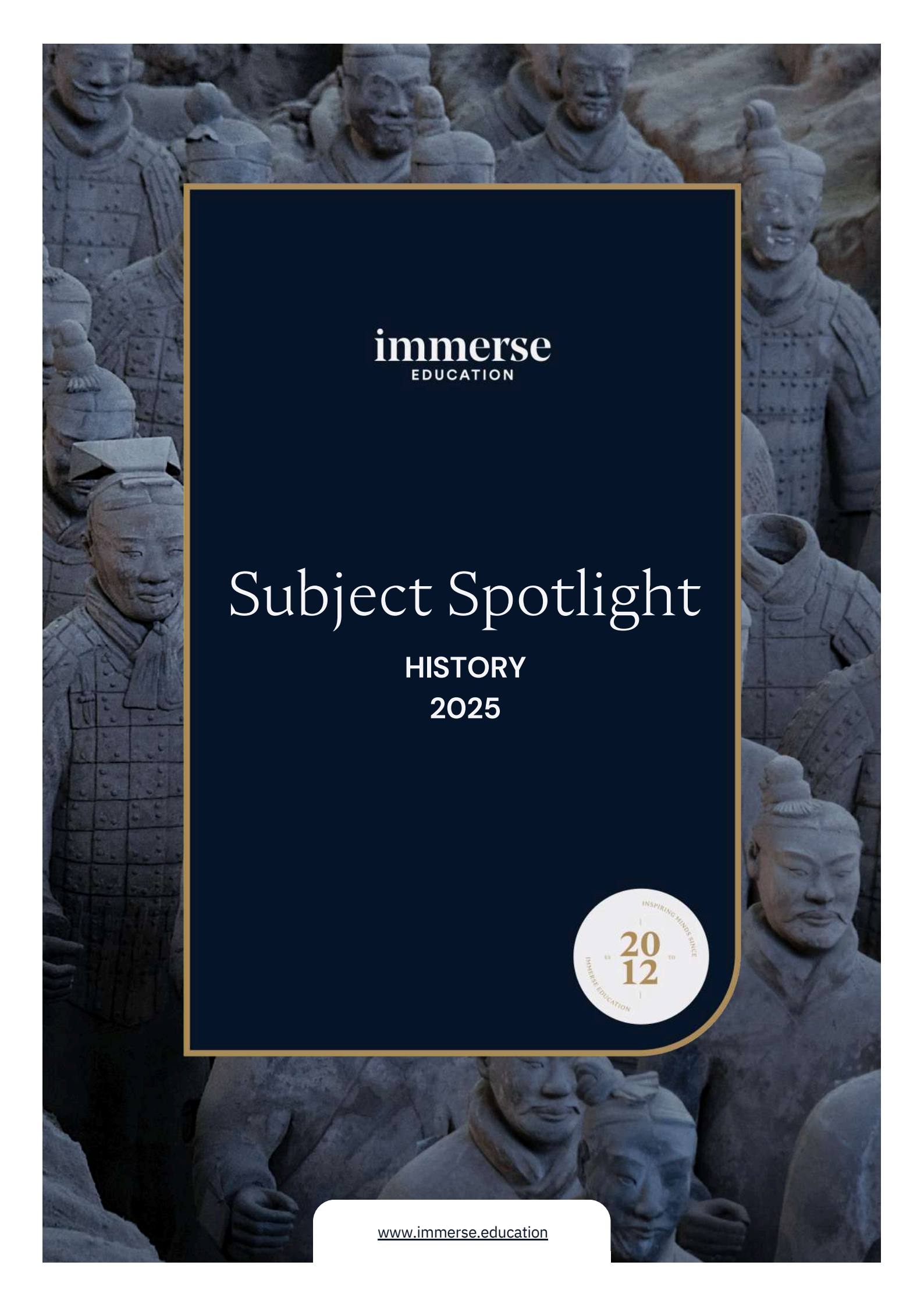

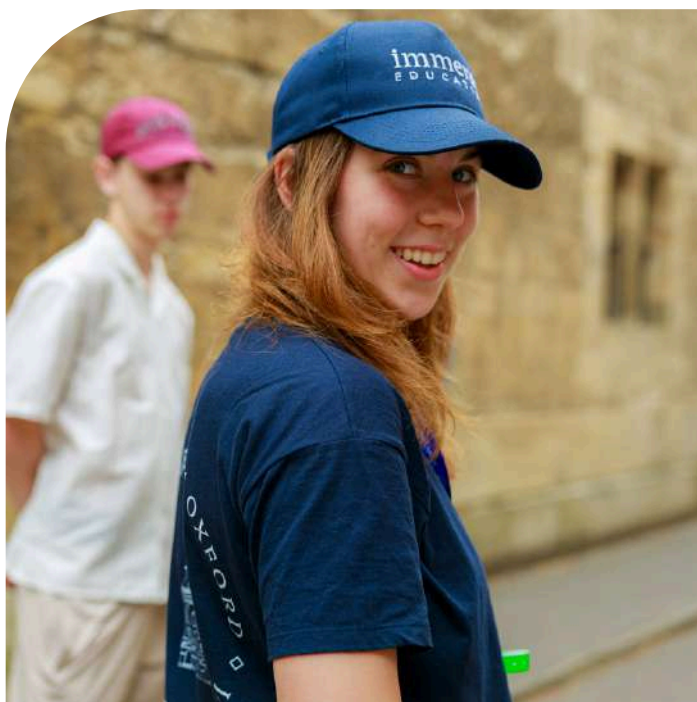
CAREER INSIGHTS

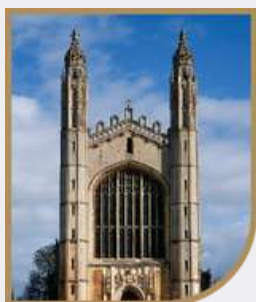

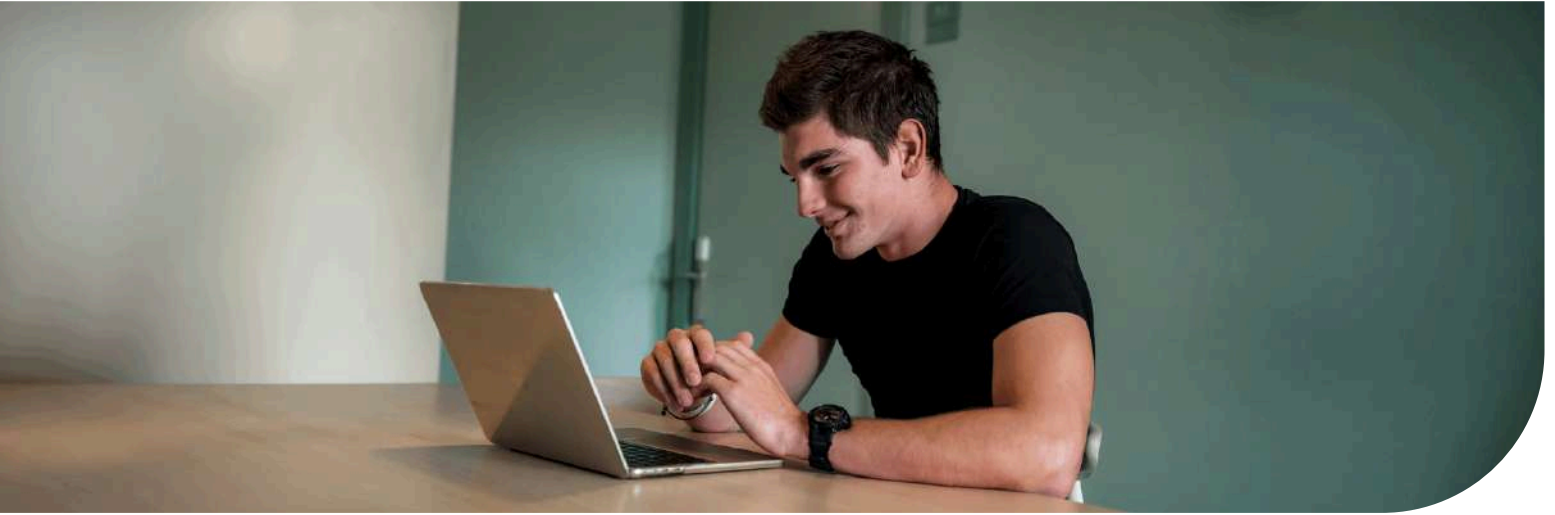
