#### Annex 1: Account Deletion & Data Retention

- You can delete your account anytime in the App.
  - Identifiable information is erased within 30 days unless legal retention applies.
  - Health records may be kept as long as required under healthcare standards (e.g., 7 years, or until age 25 if collected from a minor).
  - De-identified information may be retained indefinitely for research and service improvement.

#### Annex 2: Notifications & Communications

- **Types:** push notifications, in-app messages, occasional email updates.
  - **Purpose:** to help manage symptoms, remind you about medications, or share important updates.
  - **Control:** you can manage notifications in your device settings and unsubscribe from emails.
  - We comply with the **Spam Act 2003 (Australia)** and **Unsolicited Electronic Messages Act 2007 (NZ)**

#### Annex 3: Permissions Justification

- **Health Data (Apple HealthKit / Google Fit / wearables):** enables symptom and activity tracking.
- **Camera:** allows uploading photos of reports or medication.
- **Microphone:** optional voice notes.
- **Location:** optional, for showing local services or clinical trial opportunities.
- **Notifications:** for reminders and updates.

We only access the data types you authorise. Permissions can be revoked anytime in device settings.

#### Annex 4: Breach Notification Procedure

- CCCure monitors for data breaches and investigates incidents promptly.
- If a breach is likely to cause serious harm, we will notify you and the relevant regulator (OAIC in Australia or OPC in New Zealand, or international bodies where required).
- Notifications will include details of the breach, what data was affected, and recommended protective steps.
