

BEFORE YOU TAKE THE ROAD TEST

1. Applicant must have the following in the vehicle during the test = Valid Identification Documents – Current Insurance – Current Registration

2. Understanding Basic Traffic Signs in English – Unable to understand will result in a reschedule

Stop	Drive Straight ahead	Turn left / right at the next street	Does your speedometer work?
Slow down	Change lanes left / right	Corner stop sign or traffic light	Does your seat belt work?

3. Vehicle Inspection – Unacceptable condition of the vehicle will result in a reschedule

Tire Condition Check	Speedometer	Two Operational Mirrors	Working Horn
All Brake Lights Working	Vehicle Interior Clear	Driver / Passenger Window Operational	Front / Back Turn Signals
No Obstruction On Windshield	Seat Belts Work	Driver / Passenger Door Operational	Low Fuel / Battery

4. Customer Basic Safety Knowledge & Road Test Scoring

Basic Safety Knowledge – 1 Point Each

Locate speedometer	Locate hazard lights and demonstrate	Locate high beams and demonstrate
Engage and disengage emergency brakes	Demonstrate hand signals (left, right, and stop)	Locate windshield wipers and demonstrate
	When active emergency vehicles approach you, what side of the road must you yield to?	Locate defroster

Driving & Parking – 10 Points Each

Fails to make full STOP at Sign/Light	Fails to yield	Following distance	Impeding the flow of traffic
Crowding center line	Speeding (5-9 MPH)		

Driving & Parking – 4 Points Each

Not wearing a seat belt	Signaling	Improper use of brakes	Choice of proper lane
Improper lane change	Jump or hit curb	Parked too far from the curb	Vehicle outside of parking space

Driving & Parking –2 Points Each

Operation of motor vehicle	Position after stopping	Waits too long	Too slow
Steering	Improper turn	Vehicle not perpendicular with curb
