ARTS-BASED CONNECTORS

Nature Journaling

Observe, Connect and Express through Reflective Practice.

Nature Journaling is the practice of connecting to your surroundings and interpreting experiences through sketching and writing. It can help reframe and refocus thought patterns, increase awareness, and encourage one to be more fully present. This first session is an invitation to continue this reflective practice on one's own.

Group rate: \$2,600 Suggested group size: up to 24 people.

Artful Communication

Creative Collaboration for Thinking "Big Picture"

Inspire and strengthen your team during this creative art session. Guided by a local professional artist, participants are led through the creative process of producing expressive artwork. No experience is necessary. The challenge is to produce a work of art that creates a collaborative piece when combined with the work of others. The final piece can be taken into the workplace as a unique piece of art for your office.

Group rate: \$3,500 Suggested group size: up to 24 people.

(In)forming Clay

Creative Problem Solving and Communicating with Clay

(In)forming Clay expresses the importance of play in creative problem-solving. Facilitated by a professional artist and Banff Centre faculty member, participants explore communication, self-awareness, collaboration and some creative risk-taking through the hands-on use of clay. It can also be used as a medium for 3D storytelling and to gain new perspectives on issues and situations that arise in the workplace and in real-life.

Group Rate: \$2,200 Suggested group size: up to 30 people.

The Mind Gym

A Dynamic Workout Using Exercises from the World of Theatre

The Mind Gym is playful and energetic way to enhance creative thinking, trust-building and problem-solving. Using experiential theatre-based exercises often used in the fields of learning, coaching and communication, participants learn how to leverage trust and communication skills. The Mind Gym is ideal to use for rejuvenation or between intensely focused sessions.

Group rate: \$2,200 Suggested group size: up to 60 people.

The Social Brain Drum

Brain Activation and Mood Elevation through Rhythmic Rapport

Science shows that drumming is good for the mind and body. It can regulate our neural systems and allow for better focus and processing of information. This playful and inclusive activity opens the door to cooperation, collaboration and laughter amongst participants. It's an immersive way to break the ice and quickly establish group rapport

Group rate: \$3,000 Suggested group size: up to 40 people.

Forests and Resilience

Exploring Resilience Through the Adaptations of the Forest to Fire

For forests in Banff National Park, the most defining disturbance is fire. Like an issue facing an individual or organization, fire motivates/demands a response. Understanding the dynamic of the fire and how trees in Banff have co-evolved with this important process will provide insight into what resilience means to the forests, and to you and your organization.

Group rate: \$2,000 Suggested group size: up to 24 people.

Finding Purpose in Place

A Walk of Discovery Through Our Historic and Beautiful Environment

For centuries, people have come to Banff seeking inspiration and vision. On this Connector, participants are guided on Banff Centre's surrounding trail system to learn about the transformative mountainous environment and the people it has inspired. Stories of expeditions through the Rockies and other mountain culture themes can be explored to support your conference objectives.

Group rate: \$2,000 Suggested group size: up to 24 people.

Seek & Learn Challenge

Fun and Friendly Competition in an Inspiring Setting

This fast-moving strategic challenge gets participants out of their seats and working together in groups. Armed with a campus map and a series of destinations to reach, small teams carefully plot the best route to reach as many targets as possible. Through exploring Banff Centre, participants gain insight, knowledge and familiarity with their peers. A little friendly competition promotes a lighthearted spirit and team engagement.

Group rate: starting at \$3,000 Suggested group size: 40+ people

High Ropes Course

Challenge, Trust and Teamwork

The high ropes course at The Banff Centre provides teams with an effective experience that stimulates risk taking and builds camaraderie, culminating in a celebration of personal and team accomplishments. It is ideal for quickly bringing a team together to build trust and momentum.

Group rate: starting at \$2,500 Suggested group size: 10~24 people.

Connecting Values That Matter

Stories are the most powerful tools for organizations who want to reinforce the positive elements of their work culture. Living The Culture uses a card deck to elicit stories from the most outgoing and the most introverted members of your team. Common values are identified and shared for all participants. Develop Innovative Solutions in Uncertain Times

As cards are dealt, participants must quickly adapt and develop innovative solutions. Future thinking is a dynamic way to leverage skills in future foresight, problem-solving, and calculated risk-taking.

Group rate: \$3,000 Suggested group size: up to 40 people.
