1. Data Controller

2. Personal Data Collected

Personal data is collected only when voluntarily provided by users. This may include your name, email address, and any information contained in messages sent via the contact form or email. In addition, limited technical data such as IP address or browser information may be processed by the website hosting provider for security and maintenance purposes.

3. Purpose Of Processing

Personal data is processed for the following purposes: responding to enquiries, managing professional communications, ensuring the proper functioning and security of the Website, and improving its content.

4. Legal Basis For Processing

Personal data is processed in accordance with Article 6 of the GDPR on the basis of user consent and the legitimate interests of the Website owner in operating and maintaining the Website.

5. Data Retention

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which it was collected or to comply with legal obligations. Data is reviewed periodically and deleted when no longer required.

6. Disclosure Of Personal Data

Personal data is not sold, rented, or shared for marketing purposes. Data may be processed by trusted third-party service providers solely for the operation and maintenance of the Website, subject to appropriate confidentiality and security obligations.

7. International Data Transfers

Where personal data is transferred outside the United Kingdom or the European Economic Area, appropriate safeguards are implemented in accordance with GDPR and UK GDPR requirements.

8. Data Security

Appropriate technical and organisational measures are implemented to protect personal data against unauthorised access, alteration, disclosure, or destruction. However, no method of transmission over the internet is entirely secure.

9. Data Subject Rights

Under GDPR and UK GDPR, you have the right to request access to your personal data, request correction or deletion, restrict or object to processing, and withdraw consent at any time. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the UK Information Commissioner's Office (ICO) or your local supervisory authority.

10. Third-Party Websites

The Website may contain links to third-party websites or platforms. This Privacy Policy applies only to this Website and does not cover external websites.
