Dear Secretary Reese:

On October 23, 2025, Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC filed an application in the above-captioned docket for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity for the MVP Boost Project (Project). On March 24, 2026, Mountain Valley submitted a privileged version of the Biological Assessment for the Project and indicated that a redacted public version would be forthcoming. Mountain Valley now submits herewith the redacted public version of the Biological Assessment.

The Biological Assessment contains material that is privileged and confidential consistent with Section 388.112 of the Commission's regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 388.112, because the Biological Assessment identifies, among other things, suitable habitat and individual species occurrence data. In addition, the Biological Assessment contains privileged proprietary methodologies for analyzing potential effects associated with the Project. Mountain Valley requests that, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 388.112, the Commission treat the redacted materials as nonpublic. Mountain Valley filed a Form of Confidentiality and Protective Agreement with the Project application.¹
