## BodyWorn Cameras in Action: A Life-Saving Moment

**At Texas ISD, the integration of Utility Body-Worn Cameras (BWCs) has had a profound impact on safety, efficiency, and training. For one officer, this technology played a critical role in saving a life.**

According to Chief Larry Baimbridge of Springbranch ISD, while on duty an officer responded to a distress call involving a choking infant. Acting swiftly, he performed life-saving measures, successfully dislodging a piece of plastic from the baby's airway. His BWC captured the entire event, later serving as an essential training tool.

*"Having BWCs has had a huge impact on our response to scenes and also helps areas in which we need to improve our training," Chief Baimbridge shared.*

Beyond this life-saving incident, BWCs have transformed daily operations for the department. Officers have found the devices to be easy to use, improving response times and enhancing officer safety. "It goes without saying that adding BWCs to my department has improved our safety, compliance, and overall efficiency. 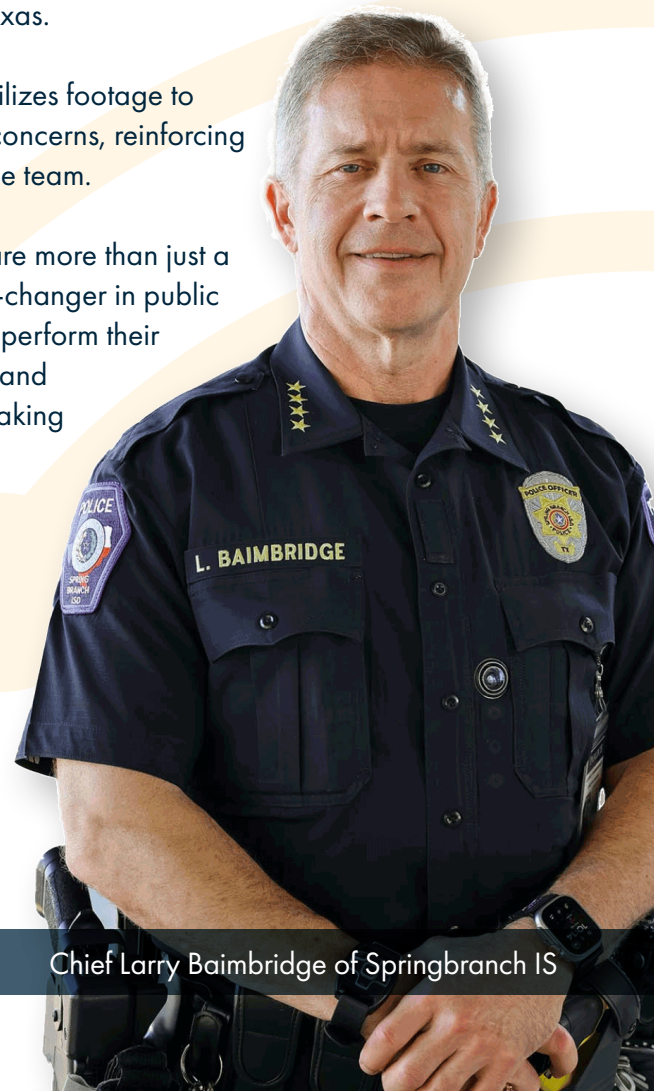
The training unit also utilizes footage to address officer safety concerns, reinforcing best practices across the team.
