Commercial & Account Info	Case-related details, settlement or payment records, account credentials, and your communications with us, including privileged communications with attorneys.

We may also collect other personal information not listed here but used as described in this Policy or disclosed at the time of collection.

2. How We Use Your Information

We use your personal information for the following purposes:

- To provide, manage, and improve legal services and case representation.
 - To communicate with you, handle inquiries, and provide updates.
 - For internal analytics, website operation, and Platform functionality.
 - To comply with legal, regulatory, or ethical obligations.
 - To send marketing or informational communications, where permitted by law.
 - For other purposes disclosed at the time of information collection.
