The Kosciusko Junction Pipeline Project (“Project”) is a timely and strategic investment in Mississippi’s energy infrastructure. Proposed by Gulf South Pipeline Company, LLC and Texas Gas Transmission, LLC—subsidiaries of Boardwalk Pipelines, LP (“Boardwalk”)—the Project will deliver meaningful benefits to our state and region.

By expanding existing pipeline facilities in western Mississippi, the Project will add 1.175 billion cubic feet per day of natural gas transportation capacity. This increase is essential to meet rising demand from power generators, manufacturers, and data centers, while also improving system reliability and flexibility for Boardwalk’s customers. Boardwalk has approached this effort with transparency and care. Throughout the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“FERC”) Pre-Filing process, the company has engaged stakeholders, provided timely updates, and conducted thorough environmental and cultural resource surveys.
