I would like to express my full support for the Kosciusko Junction Pipeline Project, proposed by Gulf South Pipeline Company, LLC and Texas Gas Transmission, LLC—subsidiaries of Boardwalk Pipelines, LP (“Boardwalk”)—as this project embodies infrastructure that is both forward-looking and grounded in safety, reliability, and community benefit.

It is my understanding that from the outset, the company has prioritized transparency and responsibility.
