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DESCRIPTION & PURPOSE

Texas Gas Transmission, LLC ("Texas Gas") is proposing the Carnation Project, which includes installing additional compression and regulation at Texas Gas's existing Crosby-Harrison compressor and regulator stations in Hamilton County, Ohio.

Compressor stations help maintain pressure and flow in the pipeline, while regulators reduce pressure as needed. The proposed facilities will support rising energy demand in the tri-state area (southwestern Ohio, northern Kentucky, and eastern Indiana). The Carnation Project will enhance the capacity and efficiency of Texas Gas's system to deliver additional natural gas to this growing region.

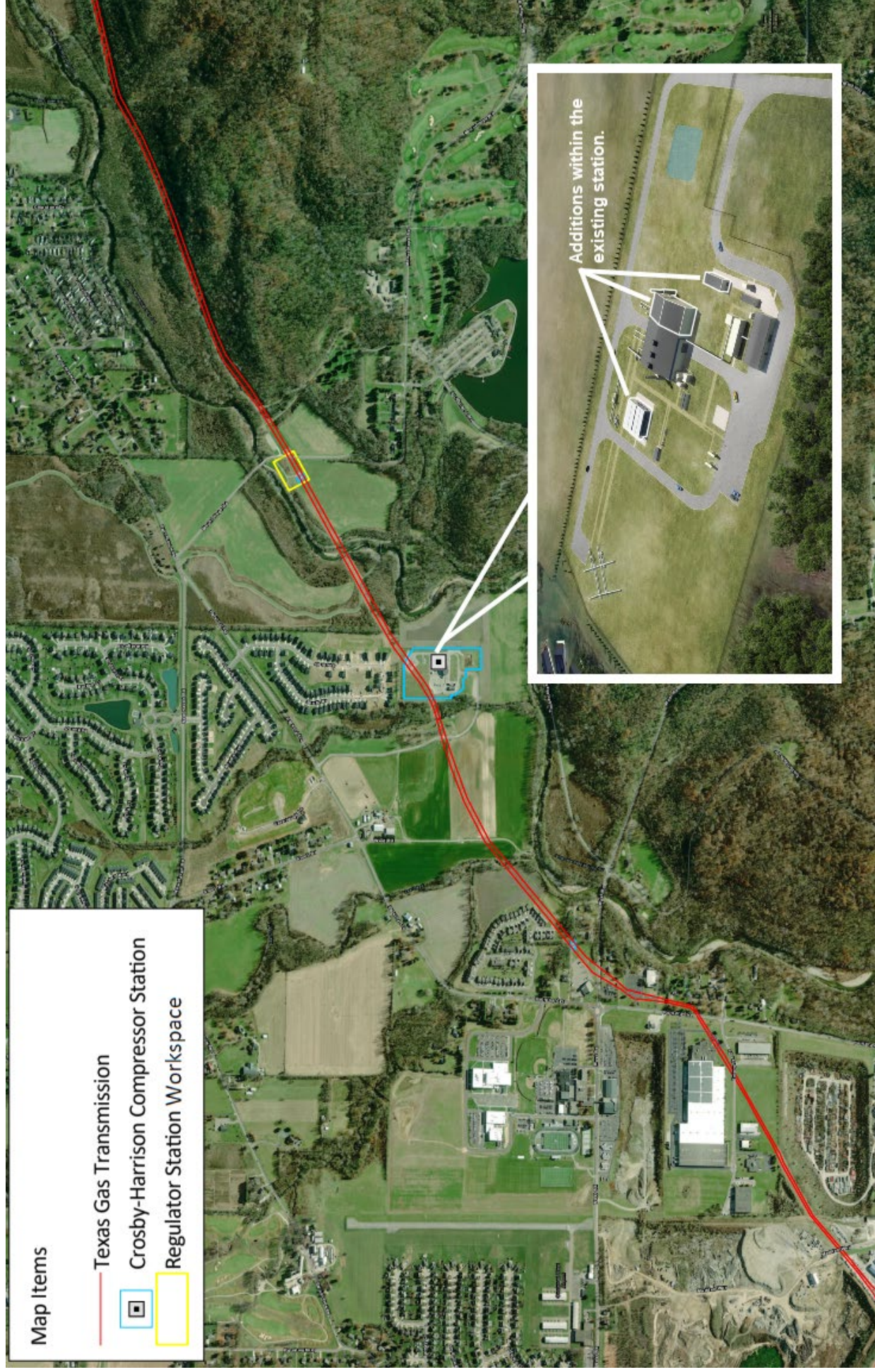
