DESCRIPTION

Texas Gas Transmission, LLC ("Texas Gas") is proposing the Dearborn County Lateral Project, which includes the construction of approximately 12 miles of new 20-inch diameter pipeline from Texas Gas's existing system in Dearborn County, Indiana, to a generating station in Hamilton County, Ohio.

PURPOSE

The Dearborn County Lateral Project will enhance natural gas capacity in southwestern Ohio, supporting continued operation of local power generation facilities and helping to ensure reliable energy for homes and businesses in the region. By expanding access to natural gas, the project provides flexibility for future energy needs while supporting the long-term stability of the area's electric grid and economy. The pipeline is proposed to run through Dearborn County, IN, Boone County, KY, and Hamilton County, KY.
