Year One Plan (2026)

Democracy Week (Summer)

- Media coverage amplifying messaging via Broadway spokespersons.

Broadway for Democracy Concert (Fall)

- Features prominent Broadway stars.
- Provides fundraising, education and awareness ahead of 2026 midterms.
- Amplifies brand, establishes nonprofit presence & mobilizes donors & partnerships.

Leading Ladies Initiative (Winter)

- Broadway actresses mentoring young women pursuing political careers.
- Skill-building workshops on public speaking, stage presence, confidence—led by Broadway actresses.
- Scholarship fund for young women pursuing careers in civic leadership.
- Mentorship network connecting young women with civic leaders.
