Completing the FMM Form

Go to www.inm.gob.mx/fmme and there you can fill out a FMM (Forma Migratoria Multiple) form. Once the page is loaded walk through the steps below to complete the form. If your trip is less than 7 days, there is no cost.

1. Select 'By Land'
2. Check the 'have read and agree to the terms and conditions above'
3. Enter the information for each section:
 - a. Entry Information
 - i. Means of entry: By Land
 - ii. Point of entry: El Chaparral (this is the name of the building)
 - iii. Date of arrival in Mexico
 - iv. Date of departure

After Completing the Form

After completing the form, you enter your email information and push the 'save' button at the bottom of the page. A confirmation including the completed form will be emailed to you. Print off the emailed form and bring it with you when you come down to Mexico. Have it on hand when you are crossing the border as you will need to present the form and your passport/passport card at the immigration. They will stamp and approve your form, keep that stamped form with you during your time in Mexico as it is your documentation for being in the country. Please read the 'FMM Directions' document to learn where to go to get the printed-out forms stamped and approved.

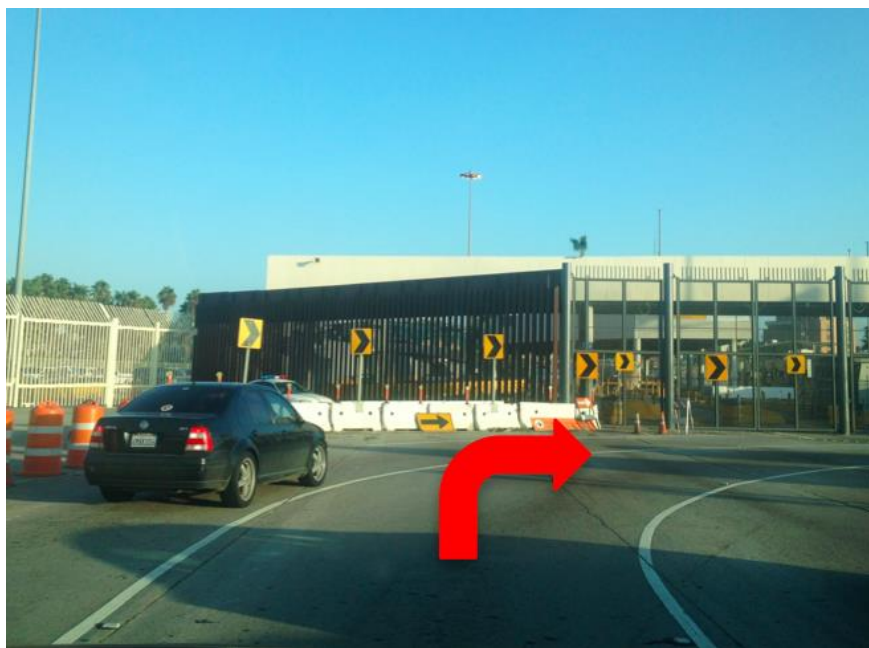
FMM Driving Directions

Getting to the Immigration Office

Visitors crossing at San Ysidro from the U.S. to Mexico and need FMM tourist permits must stop at the El Chaparral Immigration Office. See below for directions to cross at this border and how to get to the immigration office to get your FMM stamped.



This is the aerial view of how to cross and how to get to the immigration office. Notice you will need to be in the far-right lane to get to the office.



Crossing the Border

Interstates 5 and 805 will drop you right off into the border crossing. Reminder to make your way to the far-right lane so that you can easily merge over to the Immigration office.



When in the far-right lane you will see this fence, on the other side is the immigration office. Head back behind this fence.



At the Immigration Office

Once behind the fence in the above photo, park and enter the blue building. Each of your team members will need to go as they must provide their passport for proof. Walk all the way through the building and after the doors you will be in an outside foyer area. To the left will be an Immigration officer who will stamp your FMM forms. After the forms are stamped, you can proceed to cross the border.
