Building a community of care

Scope

Farrell Construction rebuilt the Nazareth Retirement Village on the historic Nazareth House site in central Christchurch. Completed over three years, the project delivered 60 duplex-format villas within the wider eight-hectare campus, creating modern homes integrated into a community of care.

Process

Working in a live environment with elderly residents required a staged approach and ongoing communication. Farrell applied innovative solutions such as prefabricated bathroom pods to improve efficiency and consistency of quality. Close collaboration with architects and consultants ensured the design balanced comfort, durability and long-term value. Farrell's carpentry team undertook all construction elements, maintaining full control over quality.

Solution

The villas were completed as promised, providing high-quality independent living while connecting directly to aged-care services on site. The project strengthened Farrell's long-standing relationship with the Nazareth Community of Care. We are proud of the work we do for Nazareth, in support of residents' wellbeing for years to come.
