Aligning design and delivery

Scope

Farrell Construction was appointed to deliver a \$4.5 million project for TransDiesel in Christchurch, comprising a new warehouse extension, new entrance and façade, external cladding, office fit-out and upgrades to the existing warehouse.

Process

An Early Contractor Involvement (ECI) phase with KVA Design and TM Consultants enabled robust value engineering and detailed planning ahead of construction. Working in a live environment required careful coordination to minimise disruption to TransDiesel's operations, supported by Farrell's risk management protocols and open communication with the client and consultants. All carpentry trades, from foundations and tilt panel installation through to cladding and fit-out, were carried out by Farrell's in-house team.

Solution

The multi-faceted design included 700m² of tilt panel and portal construction, a new customer-facing office and showroom, and structural strengthening of existing buildings. Despite the project's complexity, Farrell delivered the build in 14 months, on time and on budget, providing TransDiesel with modernised facilities to support its continued growth.
