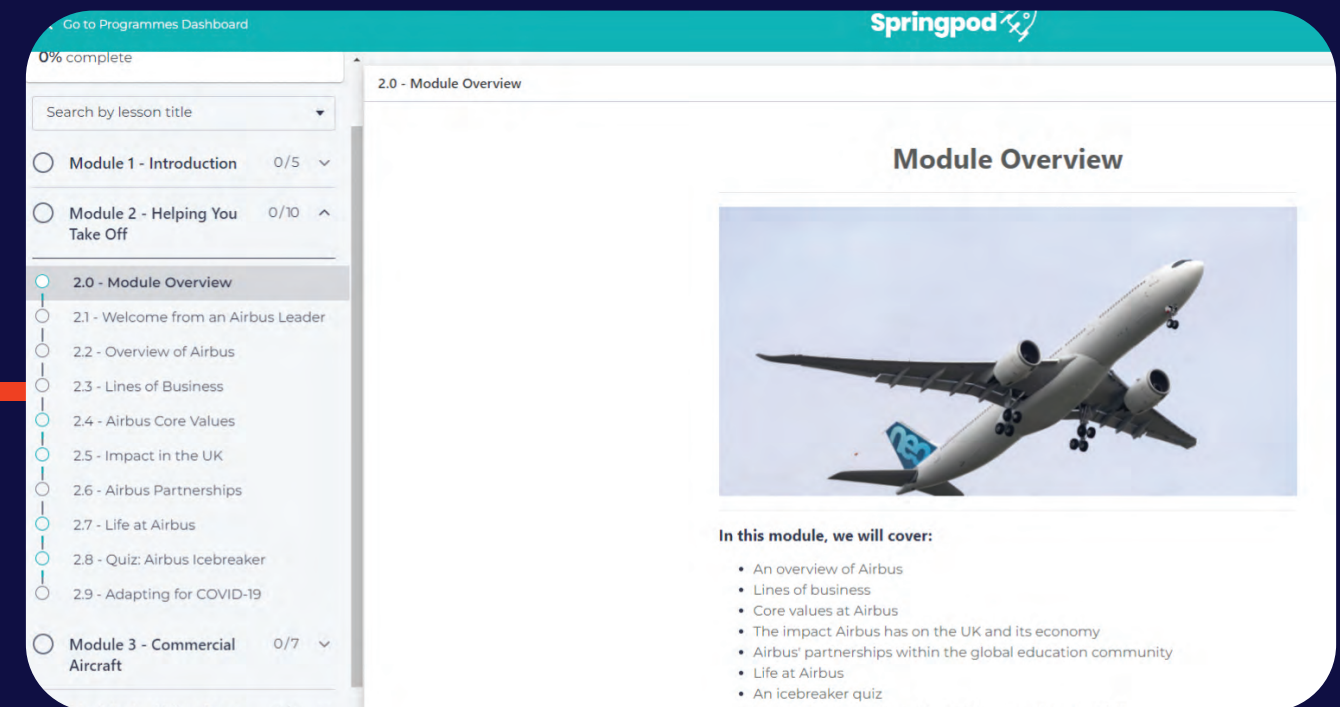

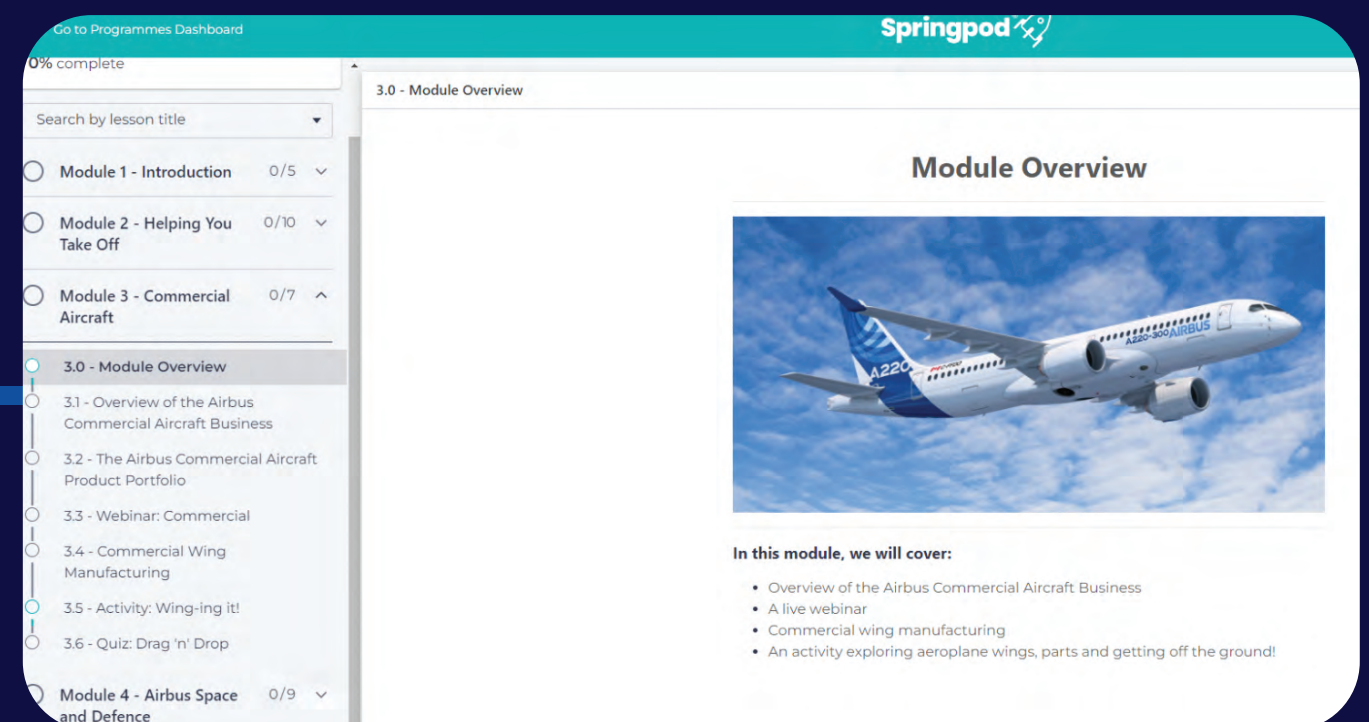
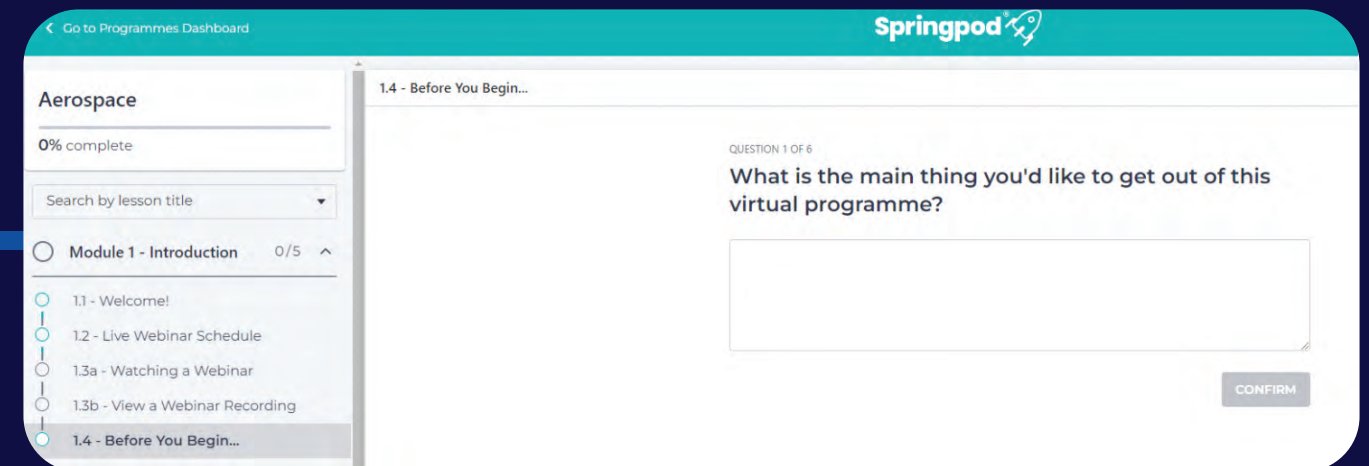
Manage Career

GenA

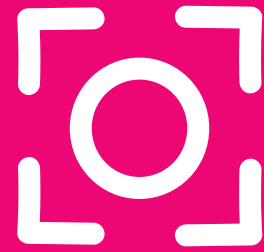
As we've already learned, there are a wide variety of employee groups at Airbus. If you do go on to get a job there, the first employee group you'll encounter will probably be **GenA**.

GenA is an employee group for Airbus' younger employees: apprentices, recent graduates, interns and others who are in the early stages of their career.

Through a combination of socials, speaker events, sports tournaments, fundraising and volunteering opportunities (and much more!) the younger generation at Airbus are given the chance to **connect, make friends in new locations, and build a sense of community**

As a member of GenA, you'll attend sessions where you'll have a chance to engage with the company, their culture and values before you're an official employee. Once you join properly, they'll arrange further team building events for you to sink your teeth into. As you progress through the early stages of your career, you'll have regular opportunities to enjoy extracurricular, social activities with your peers - and even the chance to **take the reigns and lead GenA yourself**.
