Reporting to the Survey Supervisor, the responsibilities of the Geomatics Technologist is to survey established and proposed power facilities while observing ATCO's safe practices and procedures.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Set up and operation of surveying instruments and equipment in accordance with ATCO surveying standards and safety practices.
- Make sighting decisions/recommendations on pole placement, pole height for powerline designs.
- Work with design leads for powerline and civil surveys.
- Perform topographic surveys.
- Perform construction staking for electrical facilities.
- Perform calculations related to surveying theory, powerline design, and civil construction.
- Prepare field notes or drawings showing structures to be used according to design standards or describing topography.
- Determine the alignment of crown and private easement applications or sketches.
- Establish brush clearing extents, project control and the location of other utilities.
- Perform routine maintenance on survey equipment.
- Routinely work without direct supervision.
- Frequent travel and overnight stays throughout ATCO Electric service areas and other areas as required.
- Additional duties as required.

- High School diploma or equivalent
- Completion of a Survey/Geomatics Certification program, Certification in Survey/Civil Technology from a recognized technical, distance learning institution or equivalent work experience.
- Valid Class 5 driver's license.
- Valid First Aid Certification.

- Experience with survey related instruments and software applications.
- Understanding of ATCO safety practices and procedures.
- Ability to work in rugged terrain conditions.
- Ability to work in a hot/cold seasonal climate.
