He needs a network that lets him get in-network primary care while traveling should he need it, plus coverage for urgent or emergency care.



BlueHPN may be a good option for Ryan because it provides access to in-network providers in most states, including most major U.S. cities.



Julie needs a trustworthy, local primary care doctor

Julie and her family recently moved to California and are looking for a new primary care doctor. Her family's health is her top priority, but she likes to keep a close eye on her finances, too. She's looking for a plan that helps her save money but doesn't compromise her ability to get care from an experienced, local provider that can help her family stay healthy.



BlueHPN may be a good option for Julie since it provides access to local, high-quality providers at a lower cost.



Owen needs a doctor for his daughter away at school

Owen lives in Texas and his daughter just graduated high school. She's planning to attend school in Wyoming. Because his daughter has diabetes, she will need access to doctors while she's away. However, Wyoming does not have any providers in the BlueHPN.



Owen may want to consider another network so his daughter can still receive in-network care while she's away. BlueHPN does not have in-network providers available in all cities and there is no coverage for out-of-network services except for emergencies. Check to make sure providers in your area are covered.
