
INTELLECTUAL COLLABORATION WITH ROBERT SAPOLSKY

Krupynka is a one-day online charity conference for designers of interfaces and digital products. Among the speakers were creative directors and top managers from world-famous companies like Apple, Google, and Adobe.

The charity conference raised 730,200 hryvnias, enabling 40 Ukrainian women to get free Graphic Design and Targeting education.


BLACK FRIDAY AT PROJECTOR INSTITUTE BECAME CHARITABLE
